“EXPLORING THE FOSSILS!”- Interactive Paleontology and Art workshop for children 6-11 years:

Impressions of bones and fossils, captured in the work *Metabolism* (1969) by Cypriot artist Giorgos Skotinos, at a moment when their original form is altered by time, inspiring children to approach the science of paleontology and engage in artistic experimentation.

In the first part of the workshop, children will be playing the role of a paleontologist and will have the opportunity to engage in a simulated excavation/fieldwork by discovering replicas of fossilized bones of animals that lived in Cyprus thousands of years ago. At the same time, they will participate in the preparation, observation, identification and assembly of their finds and in the process of making and verifying hypotheses. In the second part of the workshop, the children will explore shapes, forms and outlines of the fossils they have discovered and capture them on a large paper surface through drawing. The aim is to activate their imagination and interact with each other in order to create their own surrealistic and imaginary landscapes.
