<u>Question:</u> Stéphane, two things. One, do you have anything to tell us about the meeting of the Foreign Minister of Greece and the Secretary-General? And also, as I understand, Mrs. [Maria Angela] Holguin Cuellar returned from her tour to Cyprus, Greece and Türkiye. So, do you have anything to tell us about the results of this mission? I mean, will she return to the island or she's disappointed - she decided not to go back?

Spokesperson: On your second question, the Secretary-General's envoy is an extremely seasoned and experienced diplomat. I have no doubt that she will continue on her mandate enthusiastically. I don't know if she's back here in New York or when she's had a chance to brief the Secretary-General. On the meeting between the Foreign Minister and the Secretary-General, first of all, it was nice that it happened on the day that we processed Greece's full payment of its dues. They did discuss, as it would not surprise you, the bilateral relations between Greece and the United Nations. Will not also surprise you that they did discuss the situation in Cyprus, as well as developments in the eastern Mediterranean and the broader region.
