

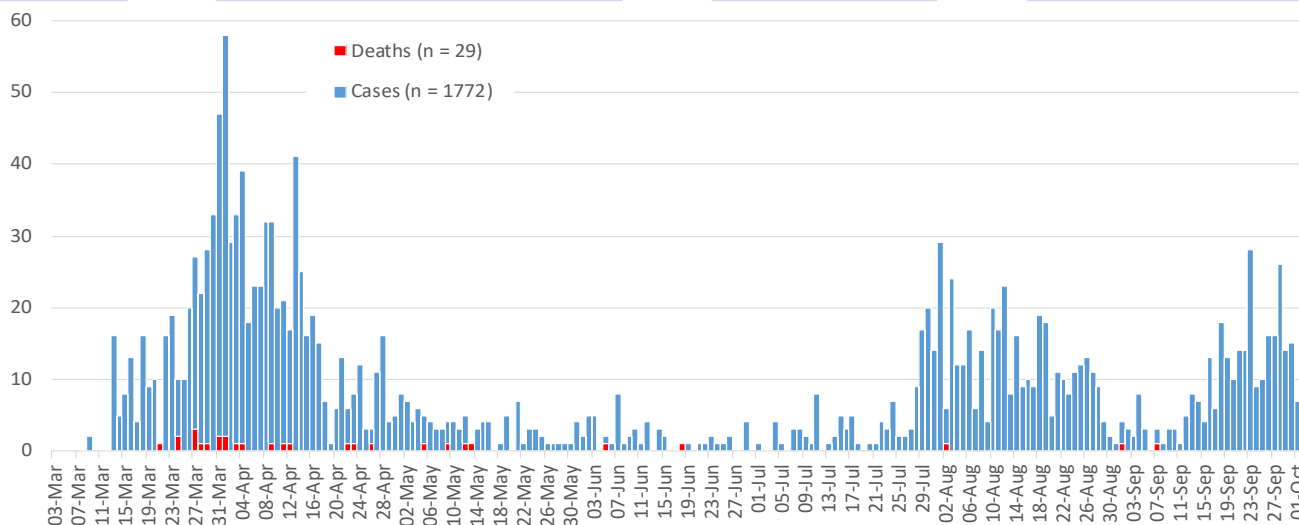

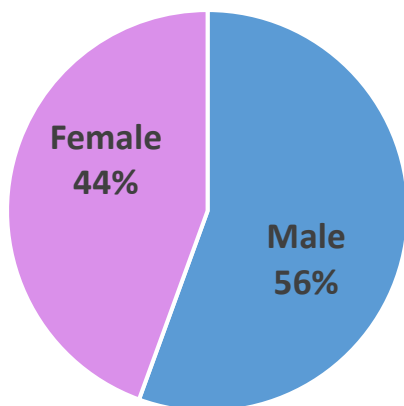
Cases	Deaths	Recovered ¹ (%)	Tests (per 100,000 pop)
1,772	29 (22 with COVID-19 as underlying cause of death)	1,426 (81.8%)	43,789.2



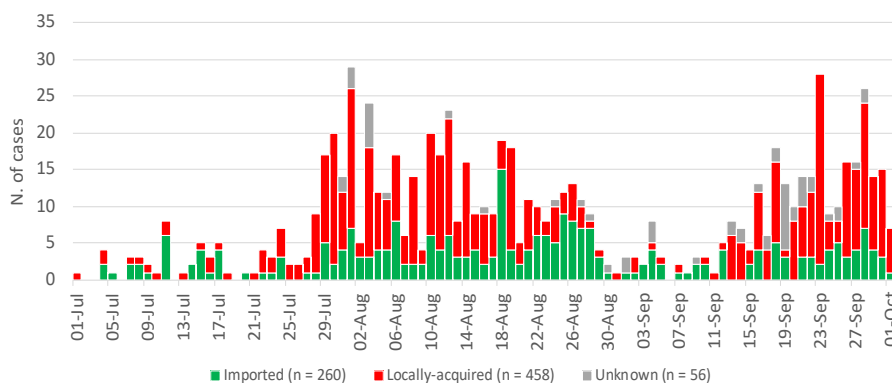
More recent data should be interpreted with caution due to the rapidly evolving situation

Characteristics of cases reported since 1st of July 2020 (n = 774)

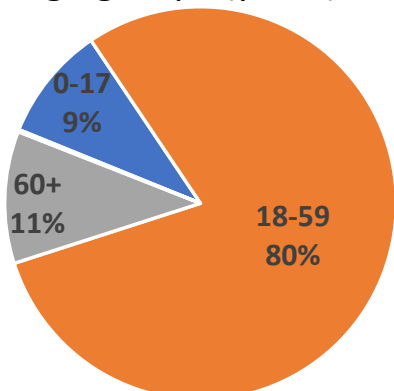
Sex
