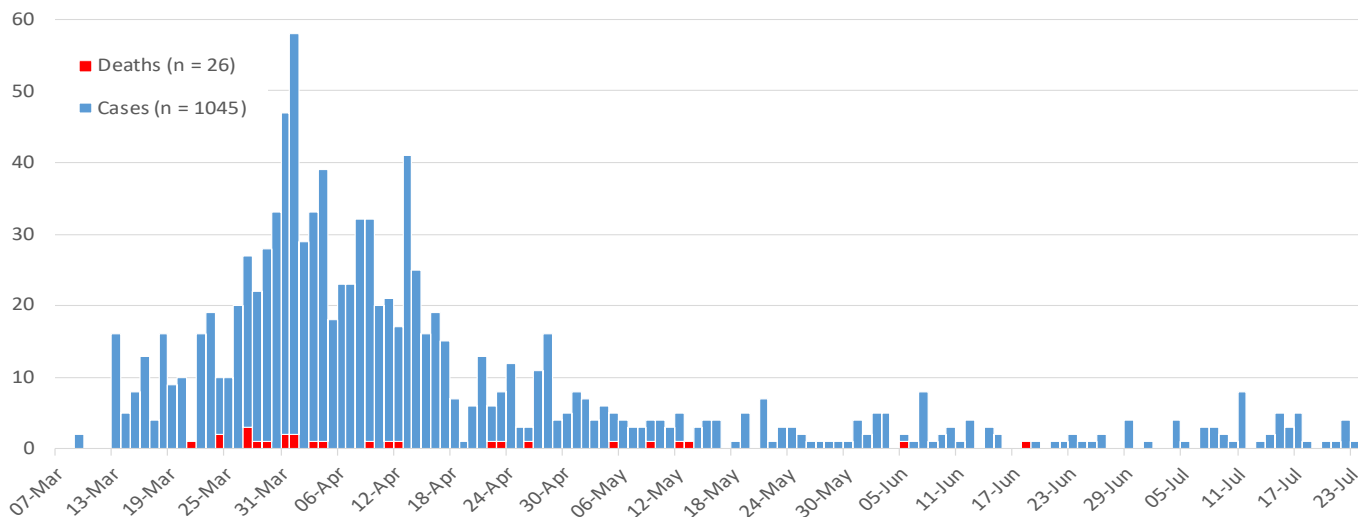

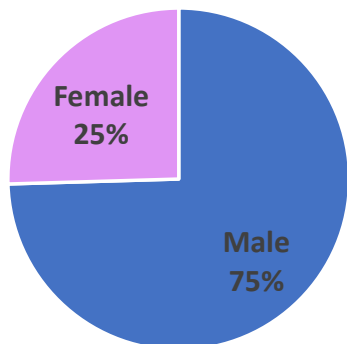

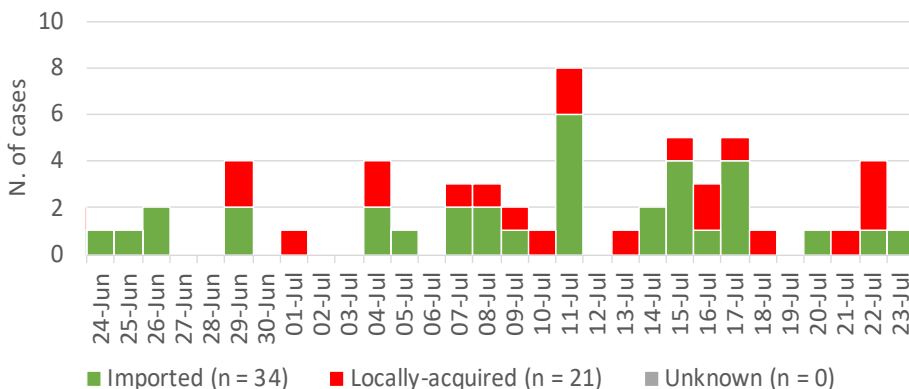

Characteristics of cases reported in the last 30 days (24/06-23/07) (n = 55)

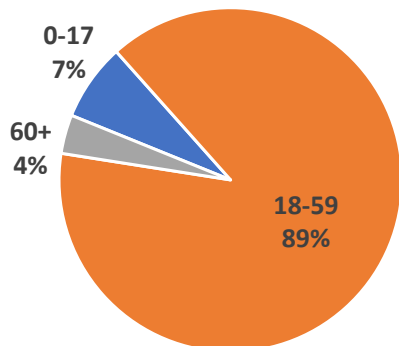
Sex
