

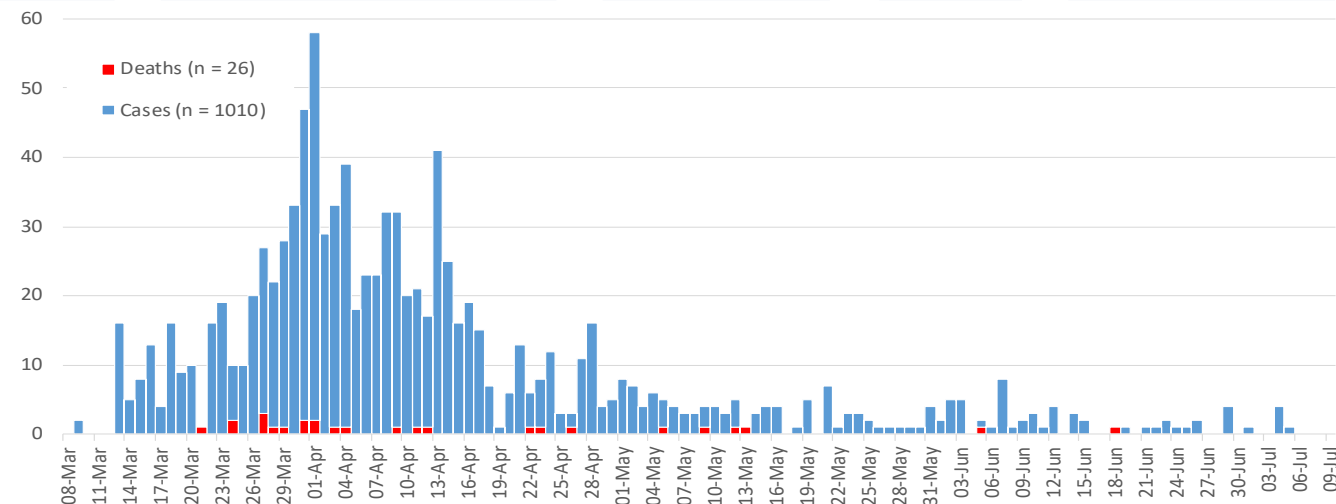

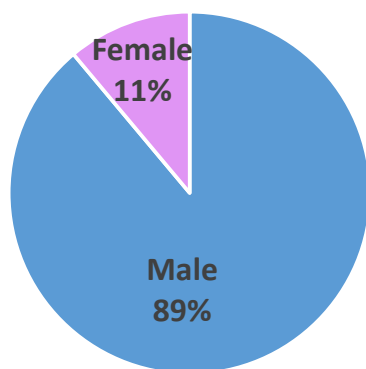
| Cases        | Deaths  | Recovered (%)      | ICU <sup>1</sup> (%) | Tests (per 100,000 pop) |

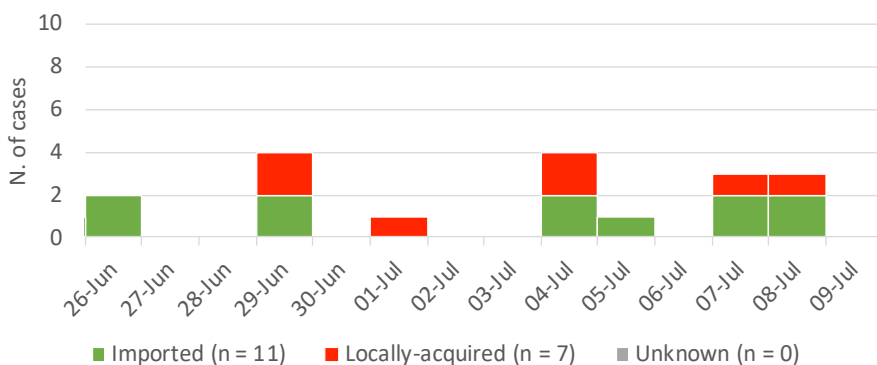
More recent data should be interpreted with caution due to the rapidly evolving situation

## Characteristics of cases reported in the last 14 days (26/06-09/07) (n = 18)

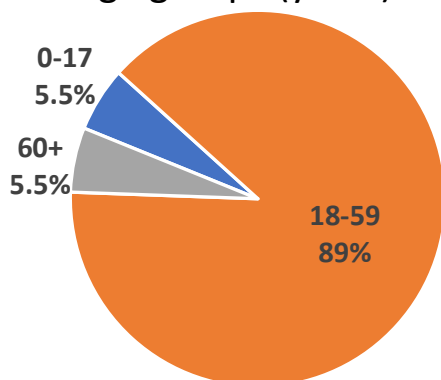
### Sex
