Provision of services to the public by the Asylum Service during the emergency measures to limit the spread of COVID-19

The Asylum Service is doing everything possible to manage this unprecedented situation and we are kindly asking the public to show understanding for any possible inconvenience caused, due to the emergency measures and the consequent absences of a large number of staff members.
