

Fourth batch of medical equipment and consumables arrives from China

The 4th batch that includes about 7 tons of medical equipment and consumables from China, arrived in Cyprus last night. It will contribute even more to the efforts made by Cyprus to tackle SARS-CoV-2 virus. Part of the batch is a donation of 140 monitors to be used to monitor patients in the Intensive Care Unit.

The new batch also includes surgical masks, swabs for sample collection and full-body protective uniforms. All those items will be immediately transported to be used by health professionals.
