

Priority services in retail establishments granted for citizens over 60 years-old and people with disabilities

Following yesterday's <u>decisions of the Council of Ministers</u> vis-à-vis the implementation of contingency measures to halt the course of the pandemic, it is recalled that the measure of granting citizens over 60 years-old and people with disabilities priority access time in food retail establishments across Cyprus, from opening time until 9am, is still in force.

More specifically, the aforementioned arrangement applies to the following establishments:

- Supermarkets,
- Fruit markets,
- Mini markets,
- Butcheries,
- Fish markets,
- Grocery shops,
- Pharmacies.

It is noted that this measure **does not apply to bakeries**, **kiosks and/or other establishments where customers can be served in a short period of time without crowding**.
