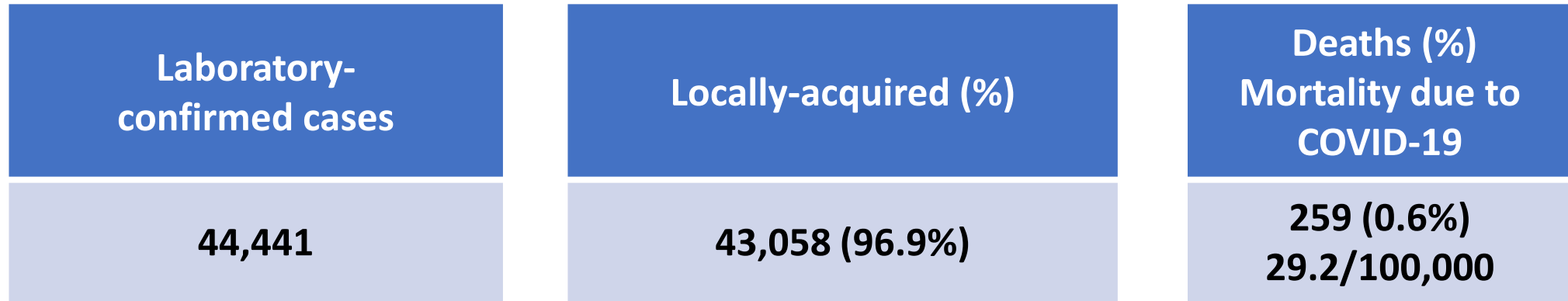

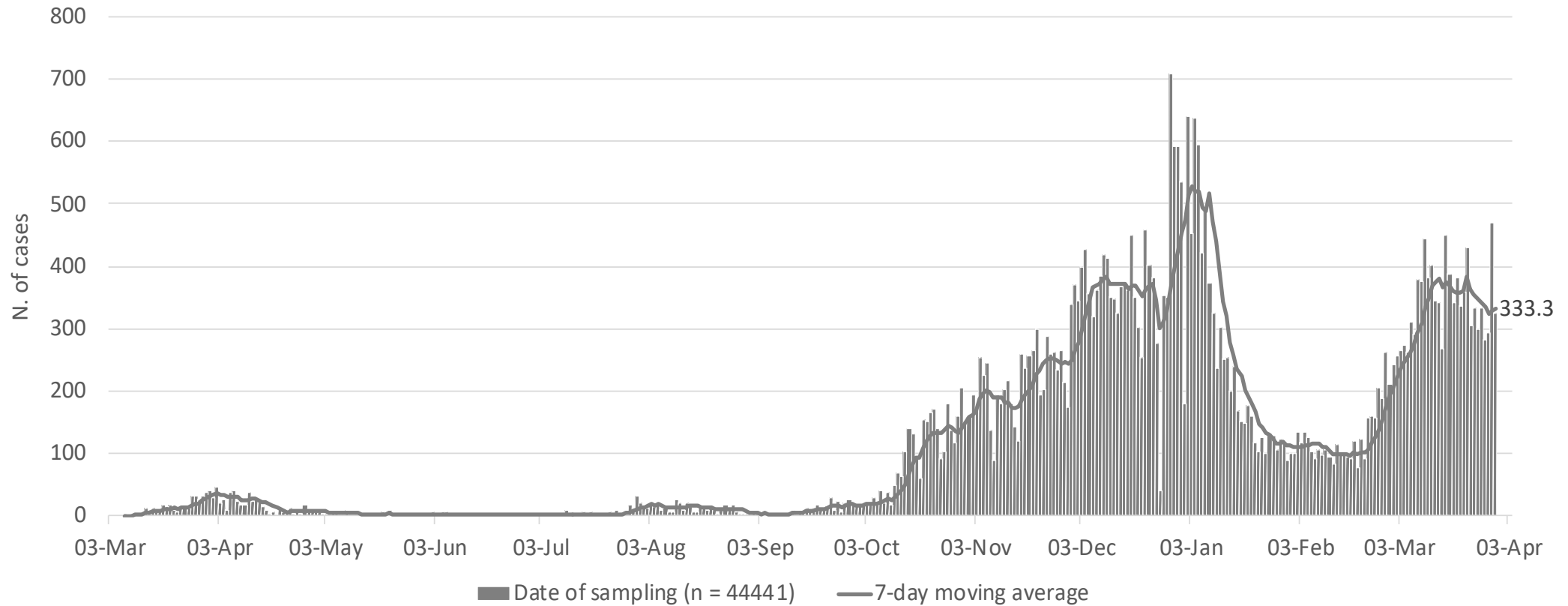

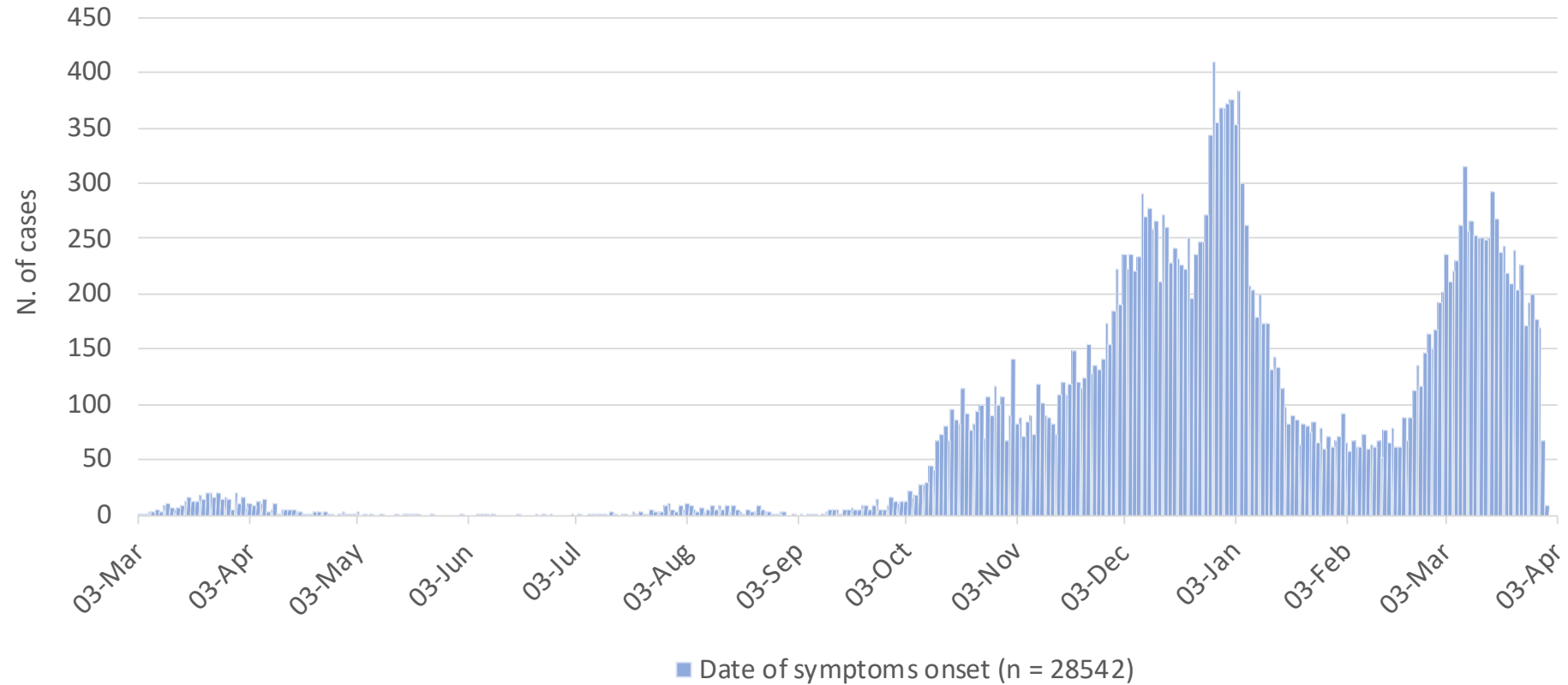

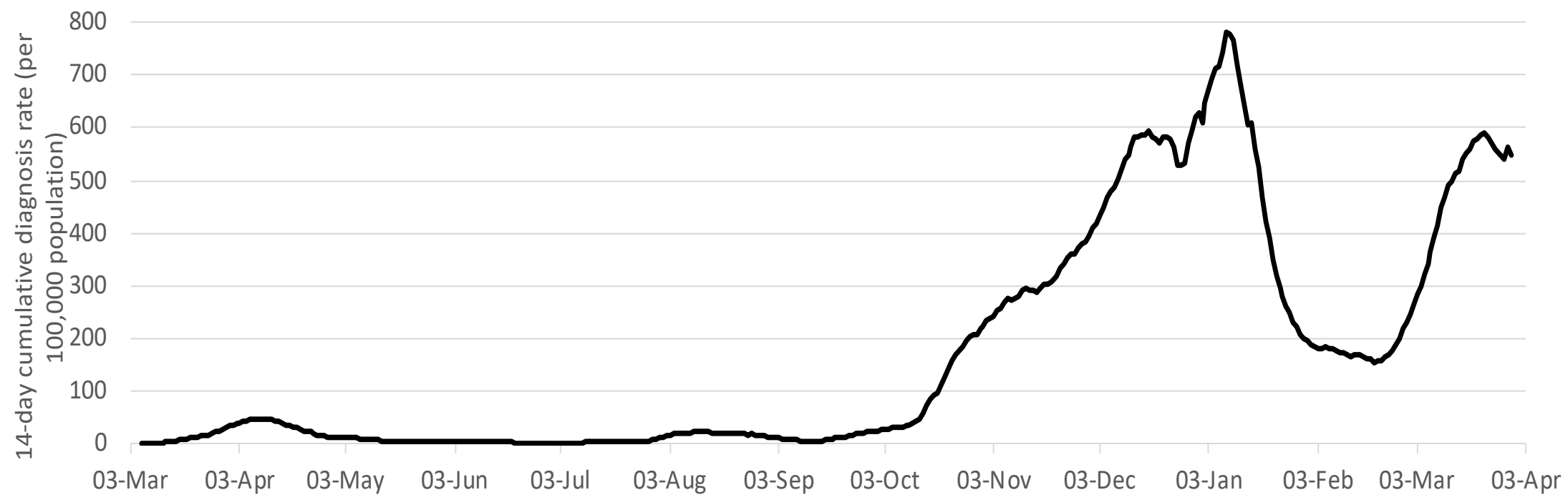


7-day moving average on March 30th is shown on the graph

COVID-19 14-day cumulative diagnosis rate per 100,000 population (proxy of COVID-19 prevalence)



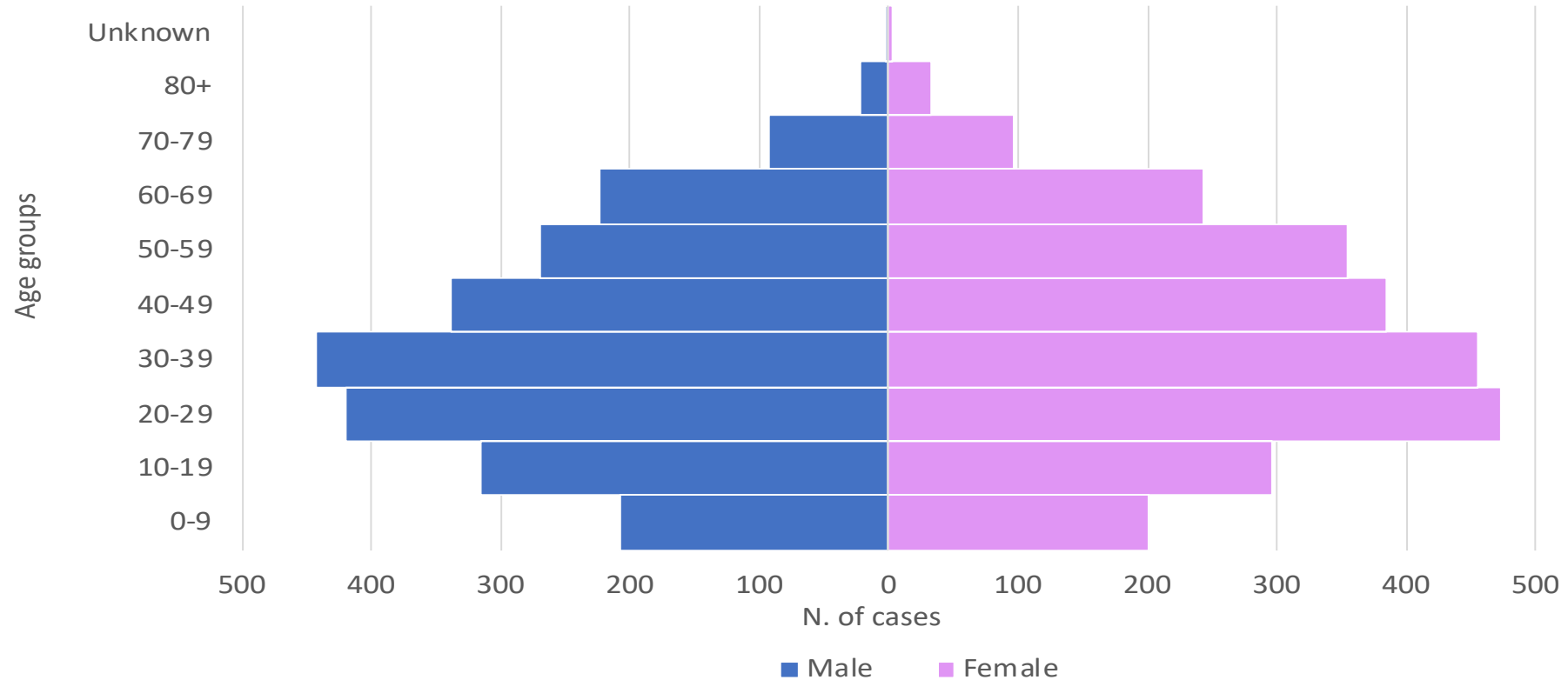

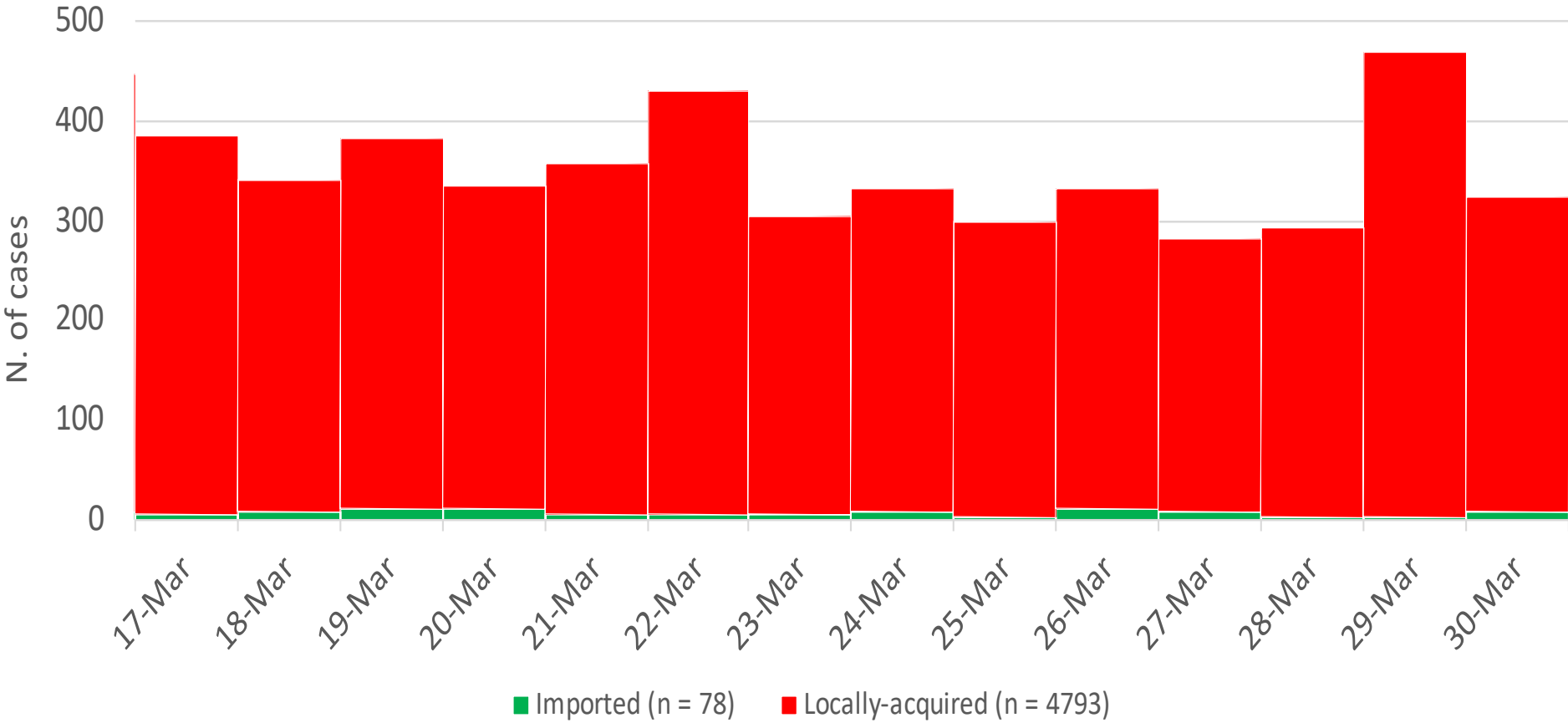

Distribution of cases diagnosed in the last 14 days by sex and age group (n = 4.871)

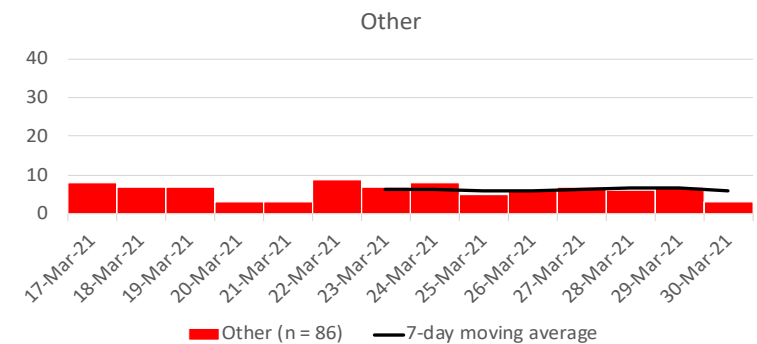
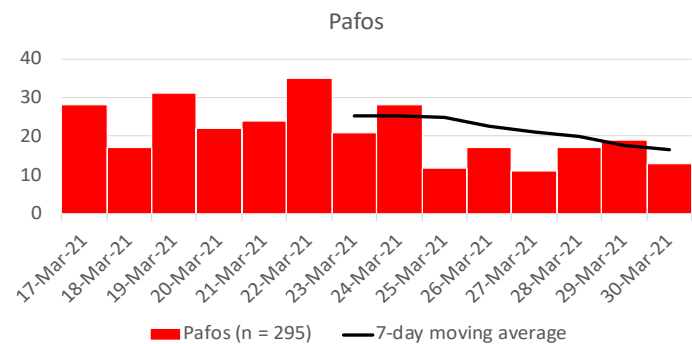
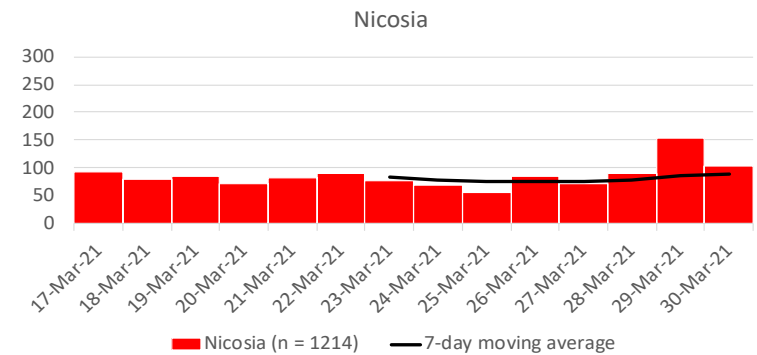
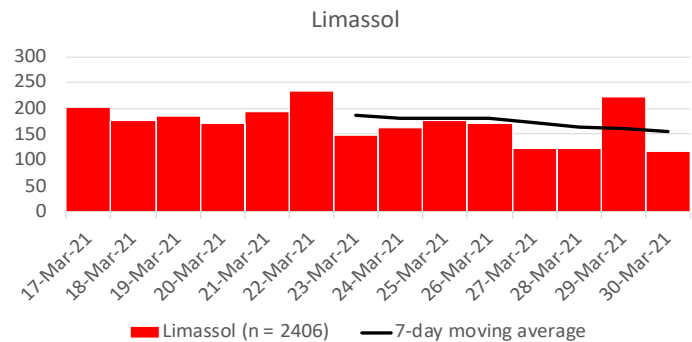
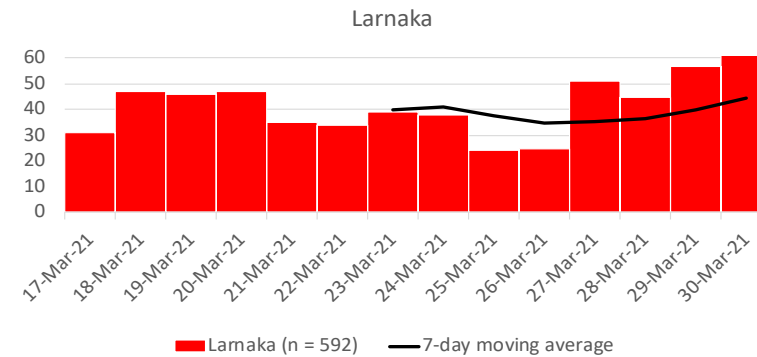
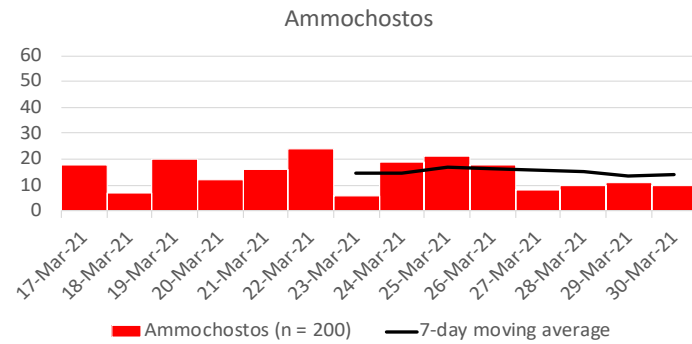

COVID-19 locally-acquired cases by date of sampling and district for the last 14 days

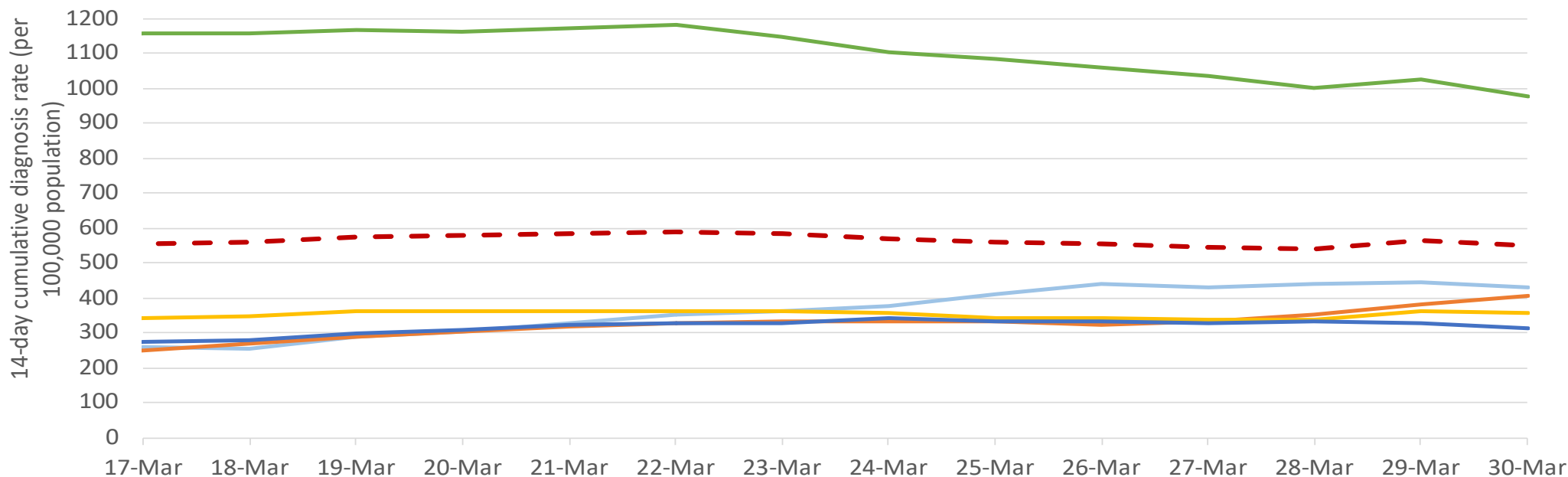

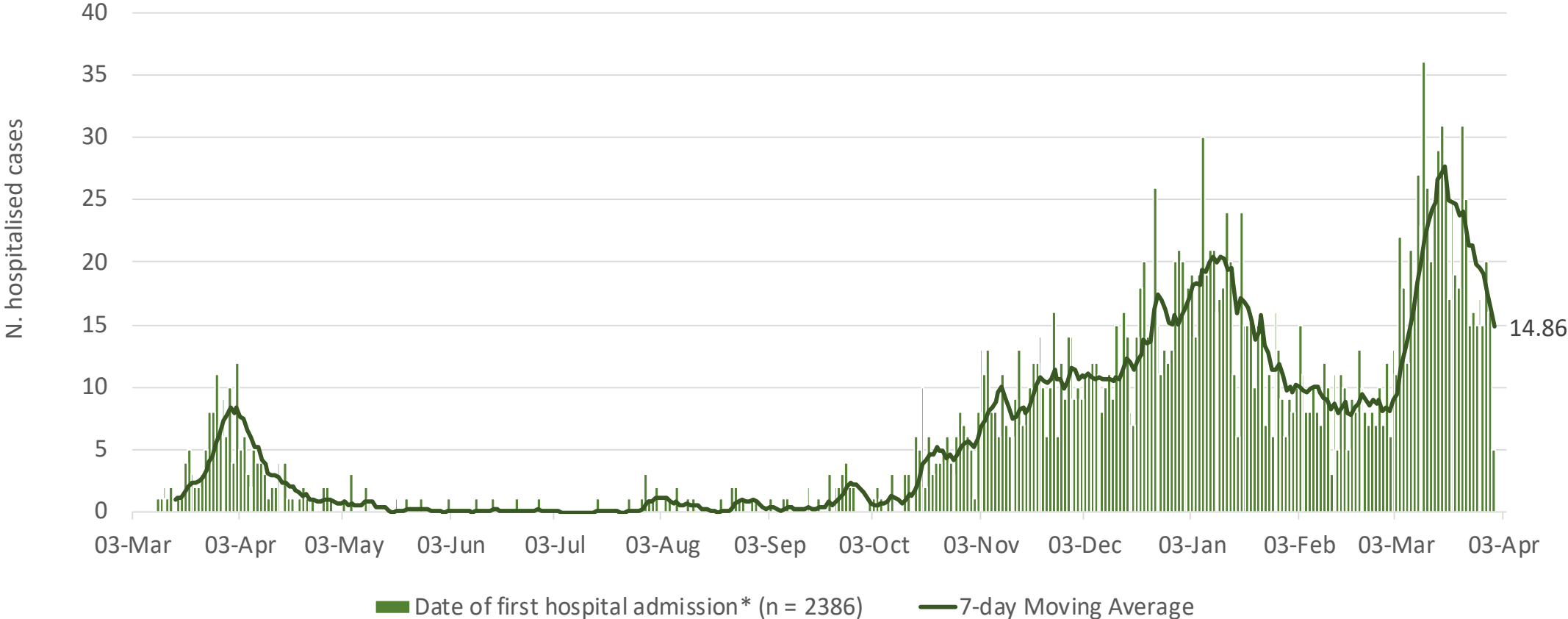
COVID-19 14-day cumulative diagnosis rate per 100,000 population, overall and by district for the last 14 days

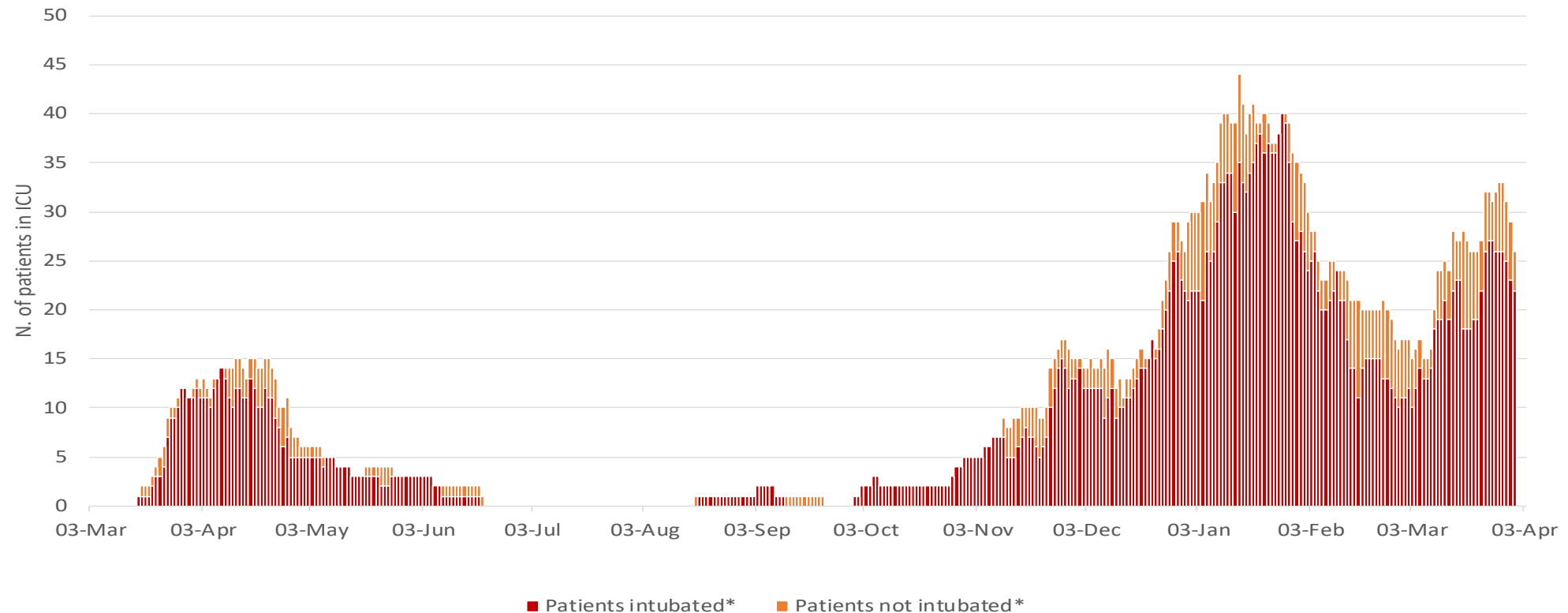
Number of cases by date of hospital admission

- Total: 244 (10,2% of all ever hospitalized patients) have ever been admitted to ICU – 26 currently in ICU (March 31st)

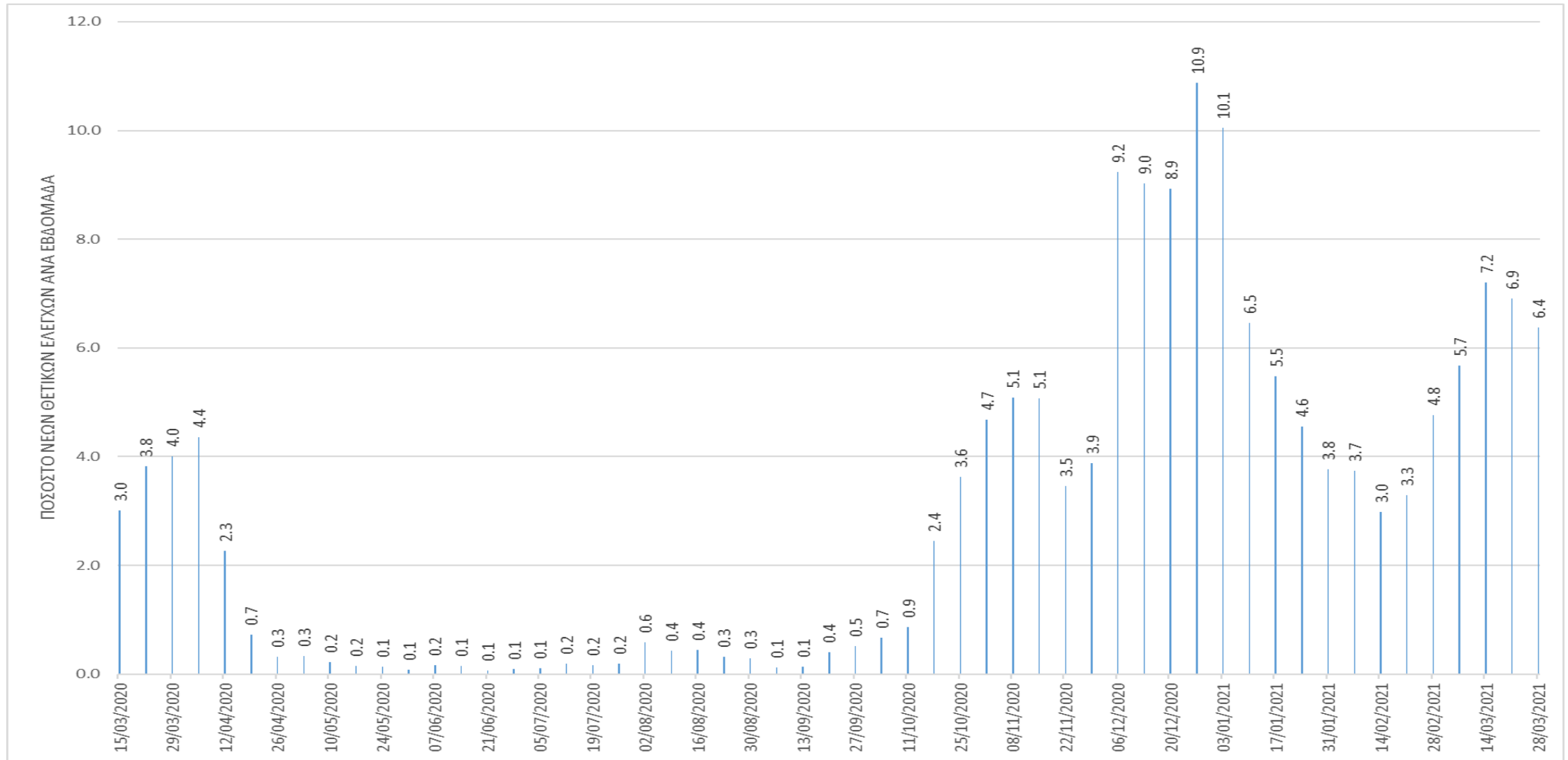

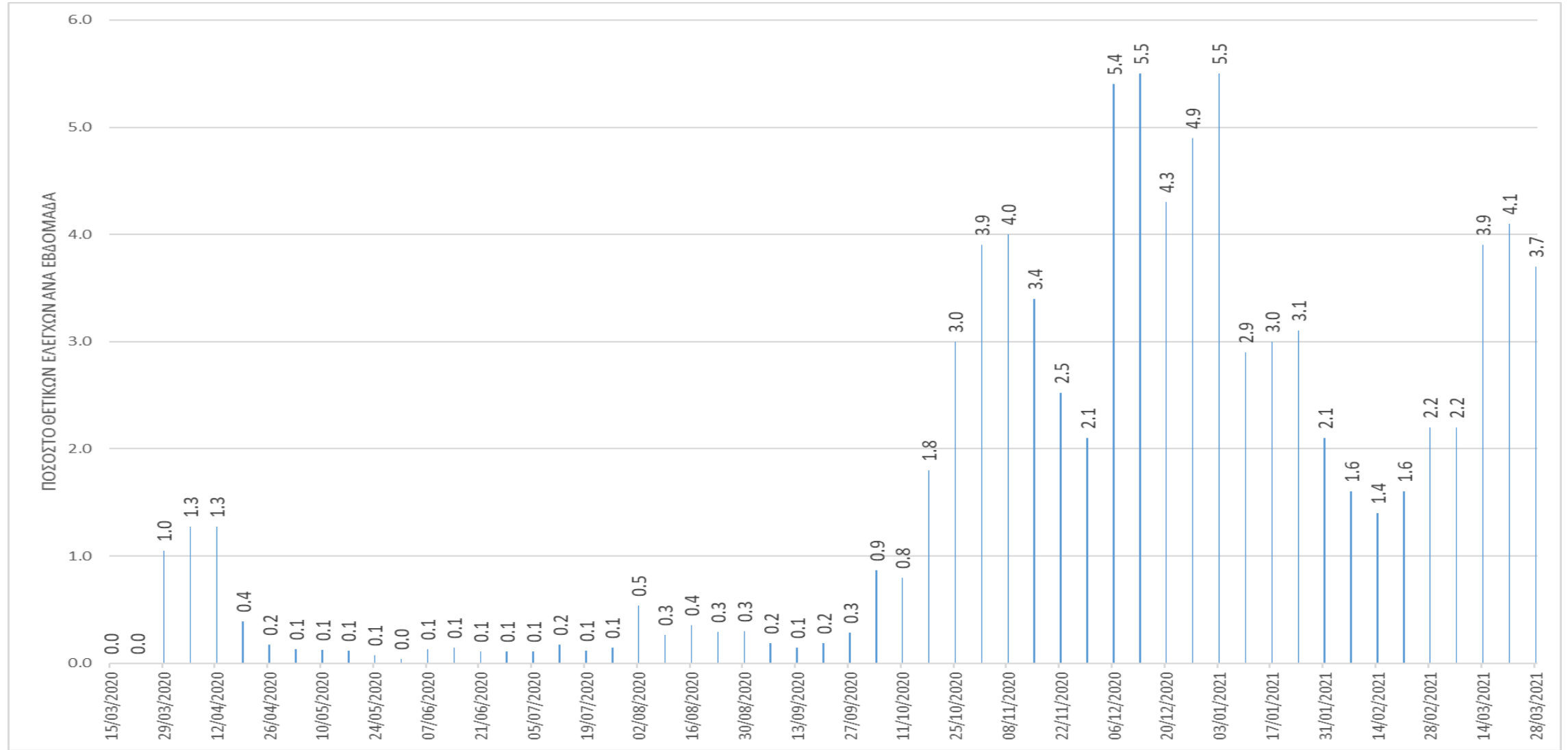

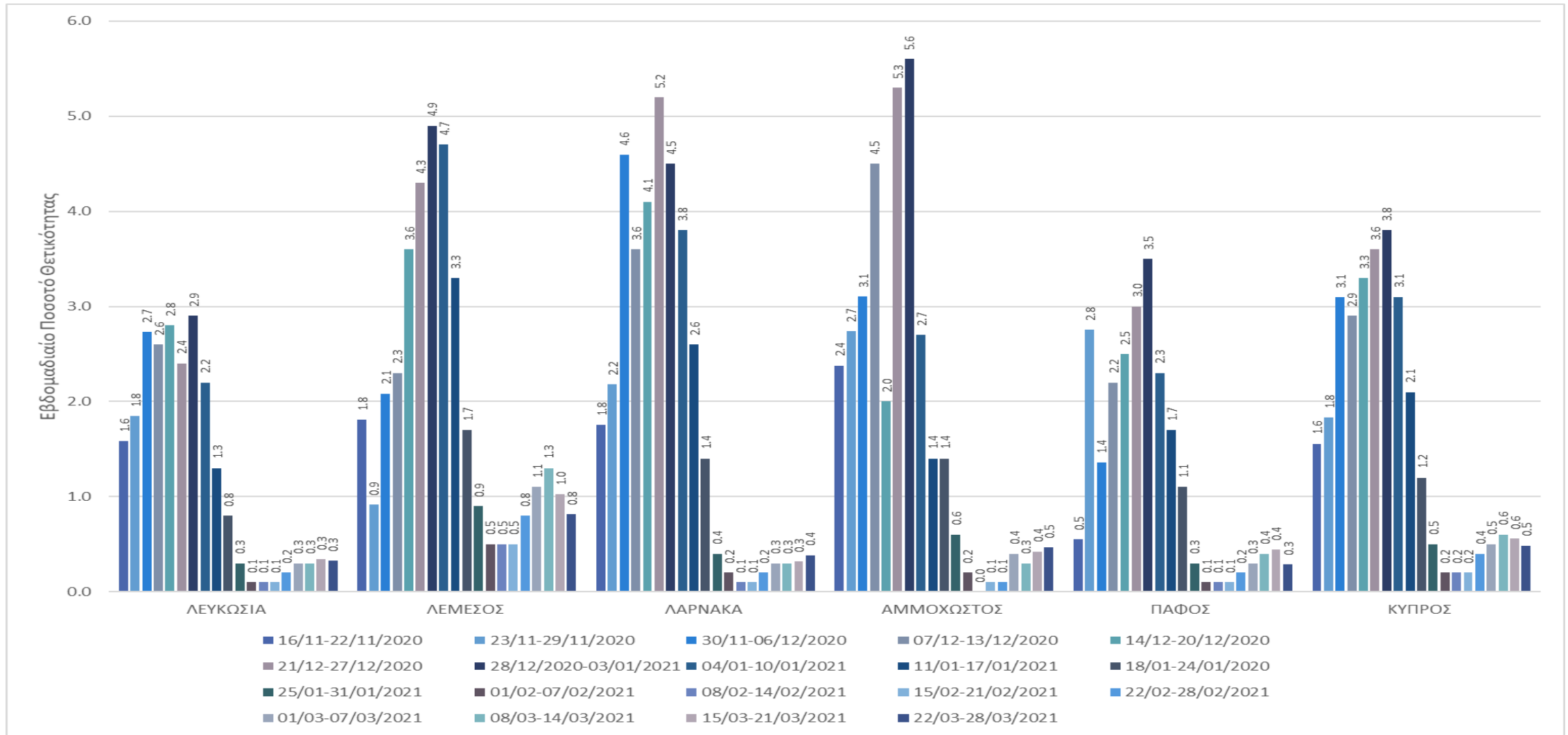
Percentage of new laboratory tests (molecular) with a positive result (all labs), per week
