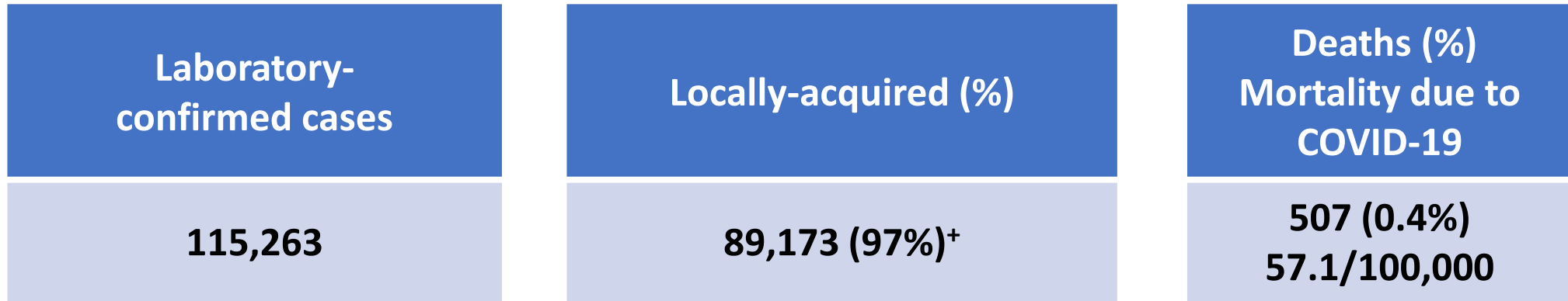

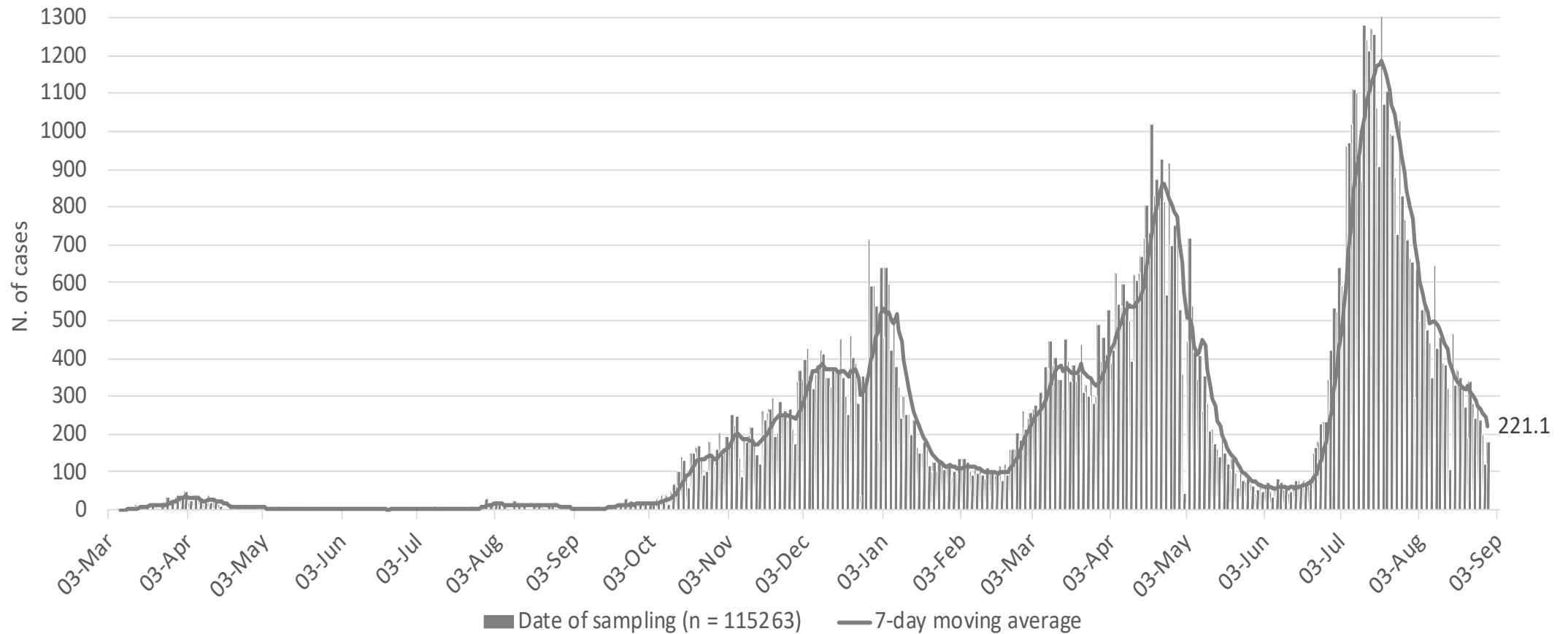

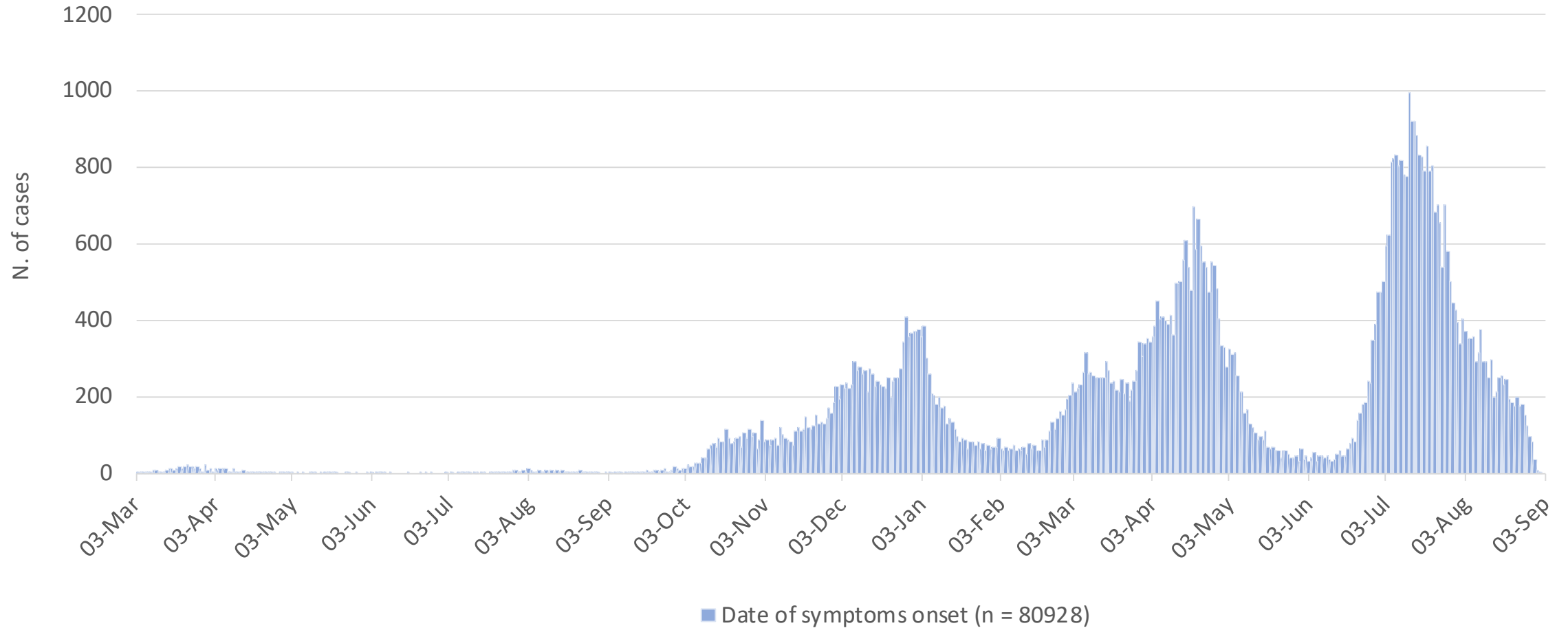

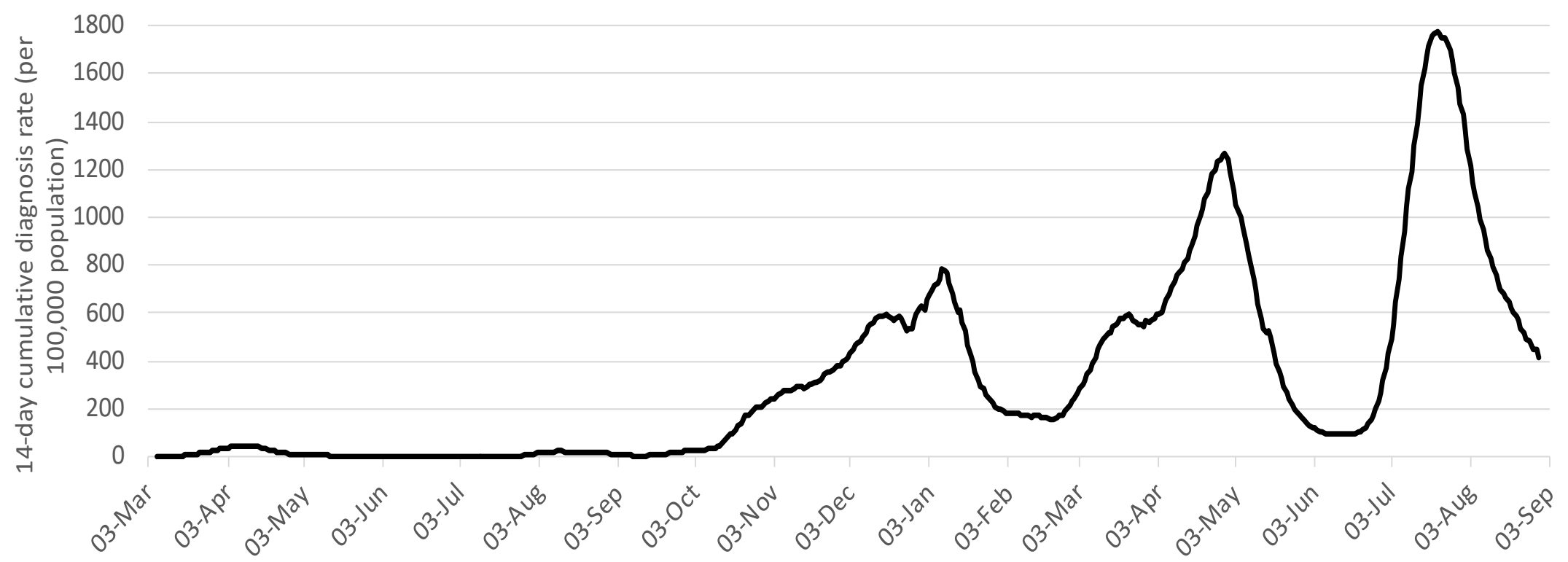


7-day moving average on August 30th is shown on the graph

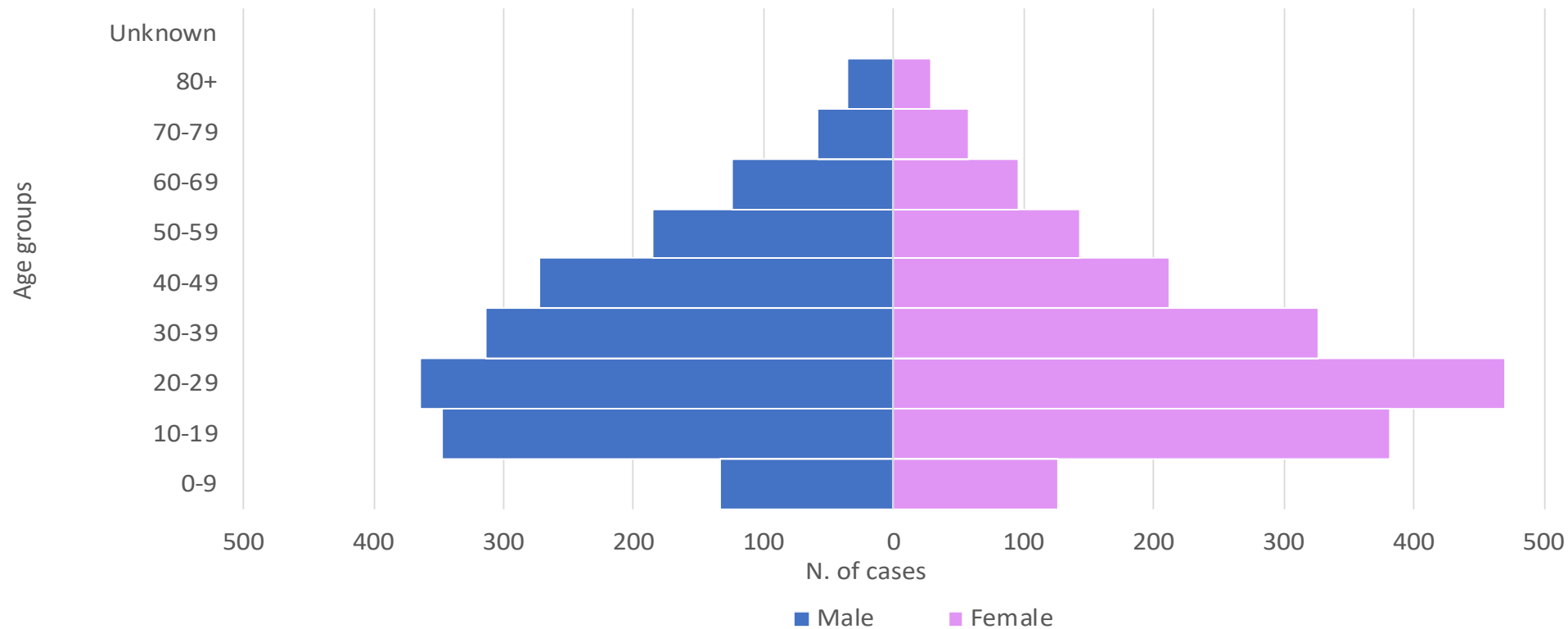

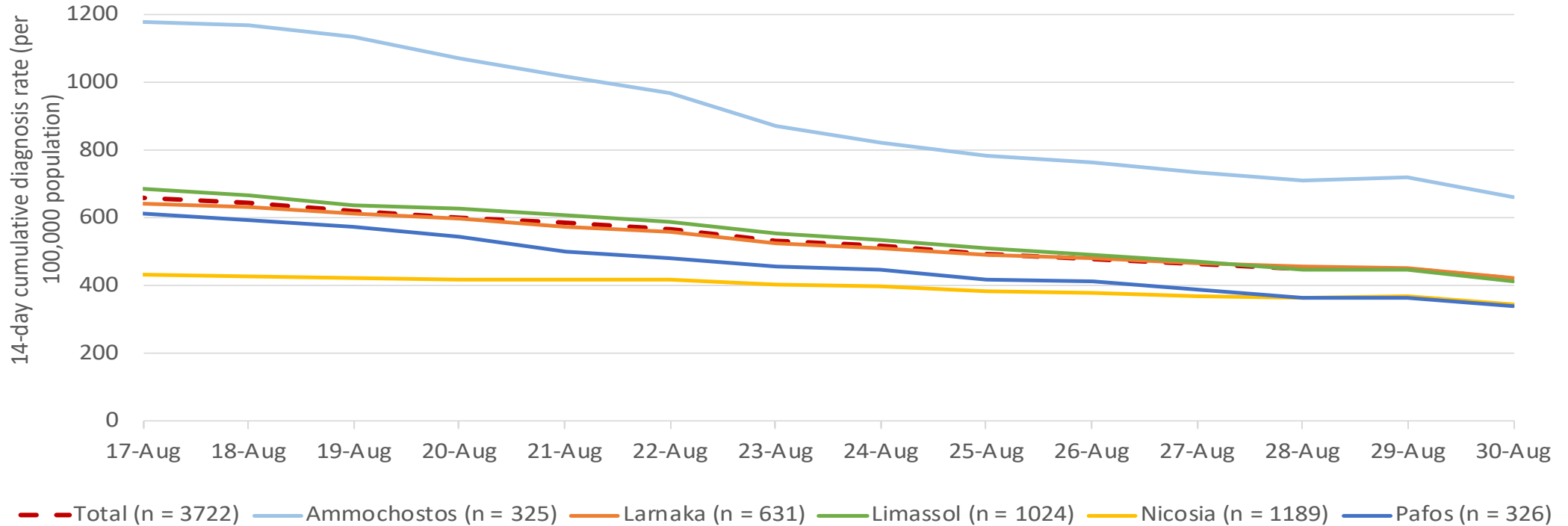

Distribution of cases diagnosed in the last 14 days by sex and age group (information on gender available for n = 3,680/3,722 – 98.9%)



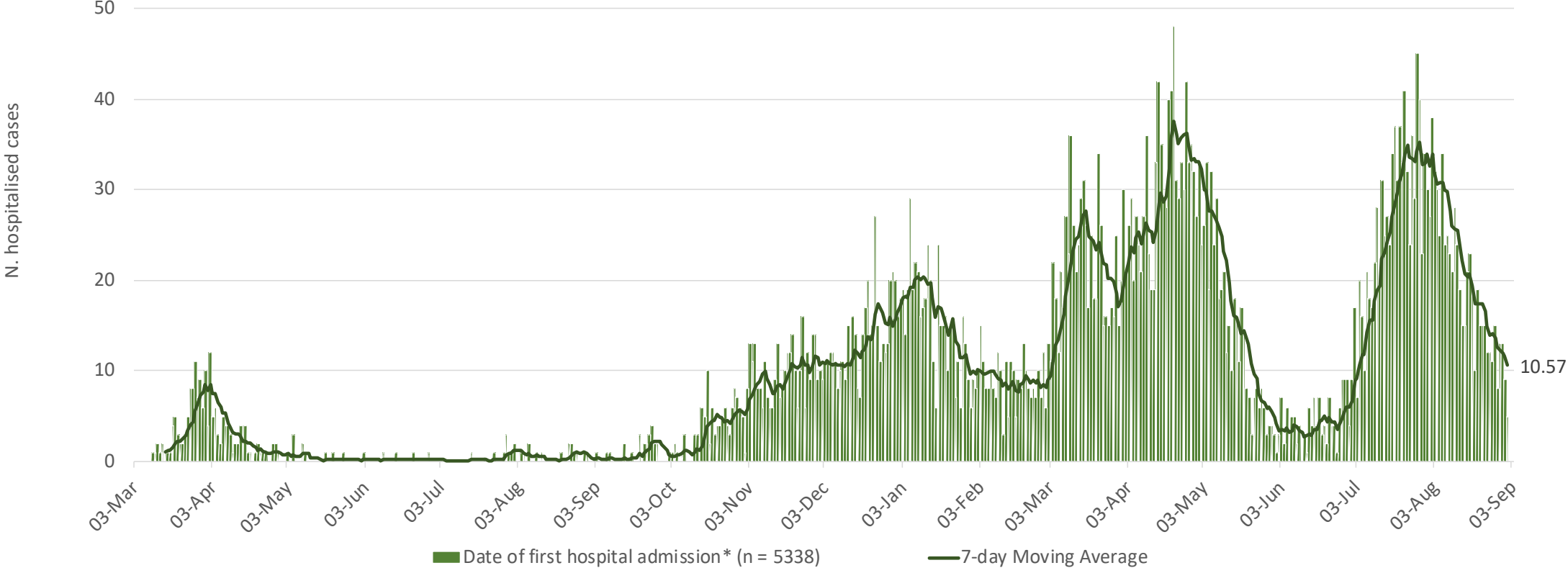

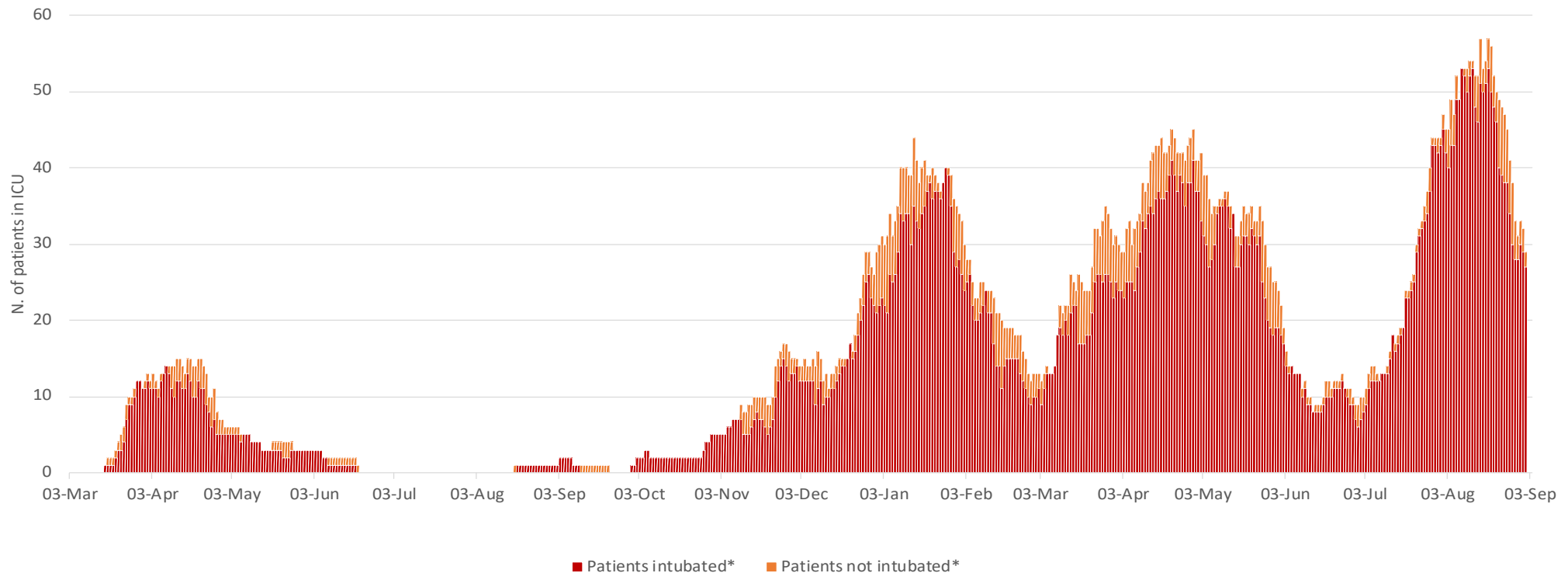
Number of cases by date of hospital admission

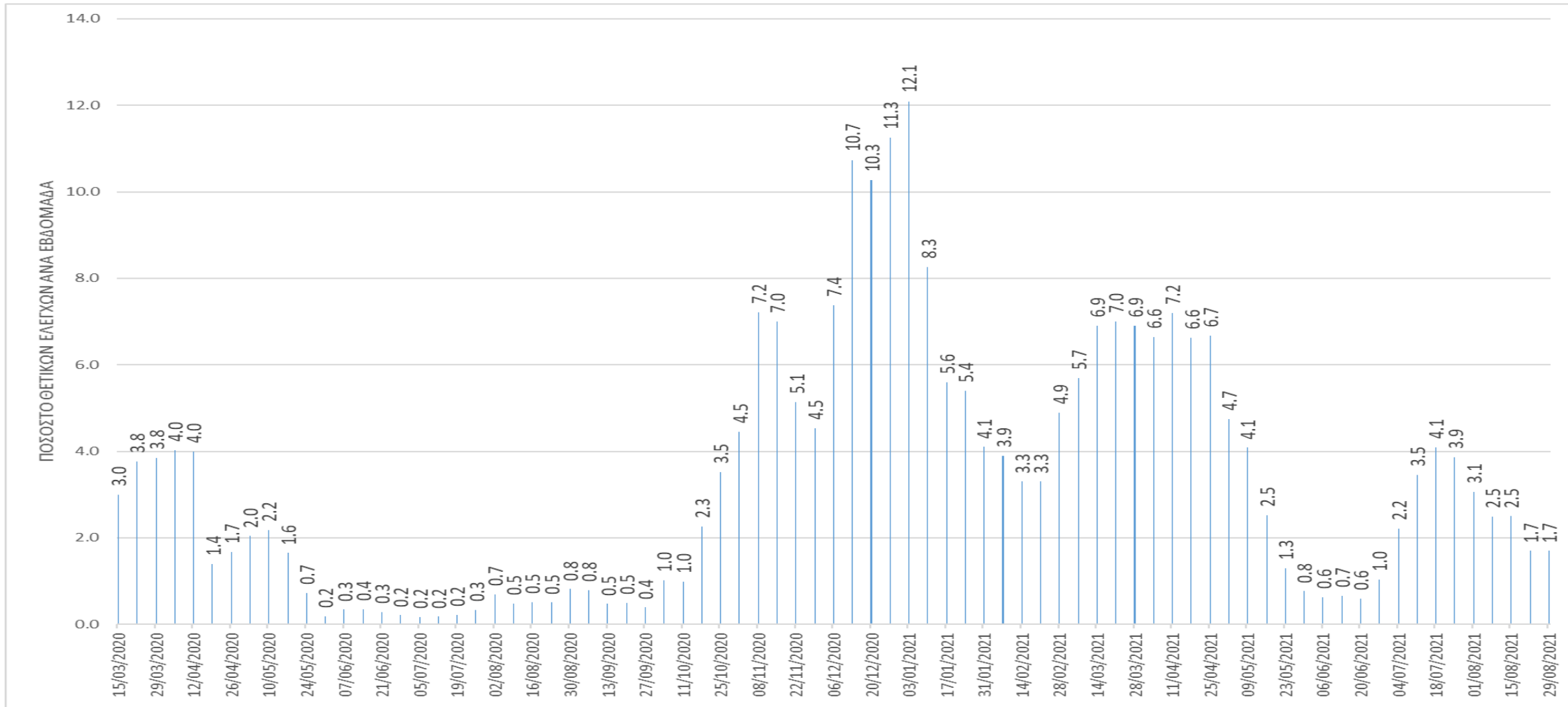

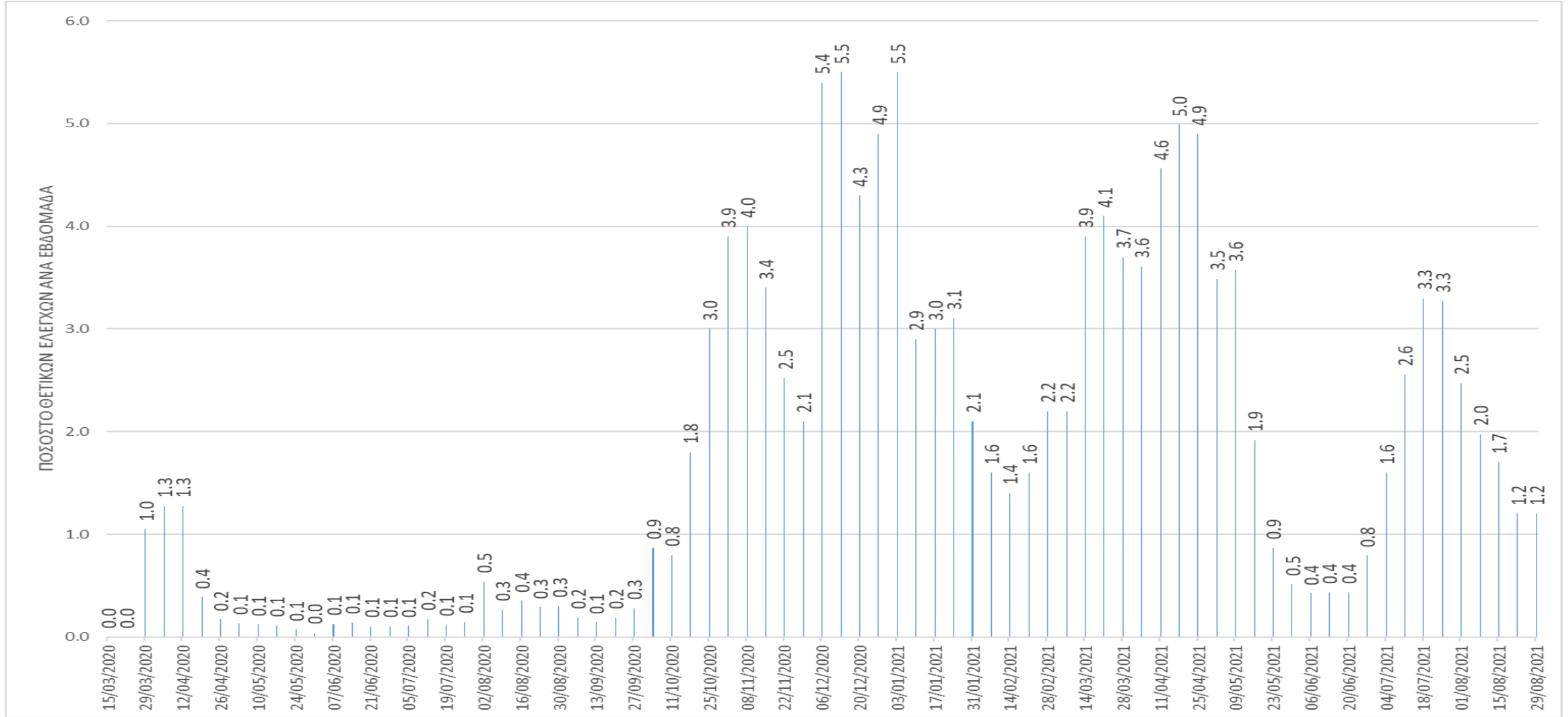

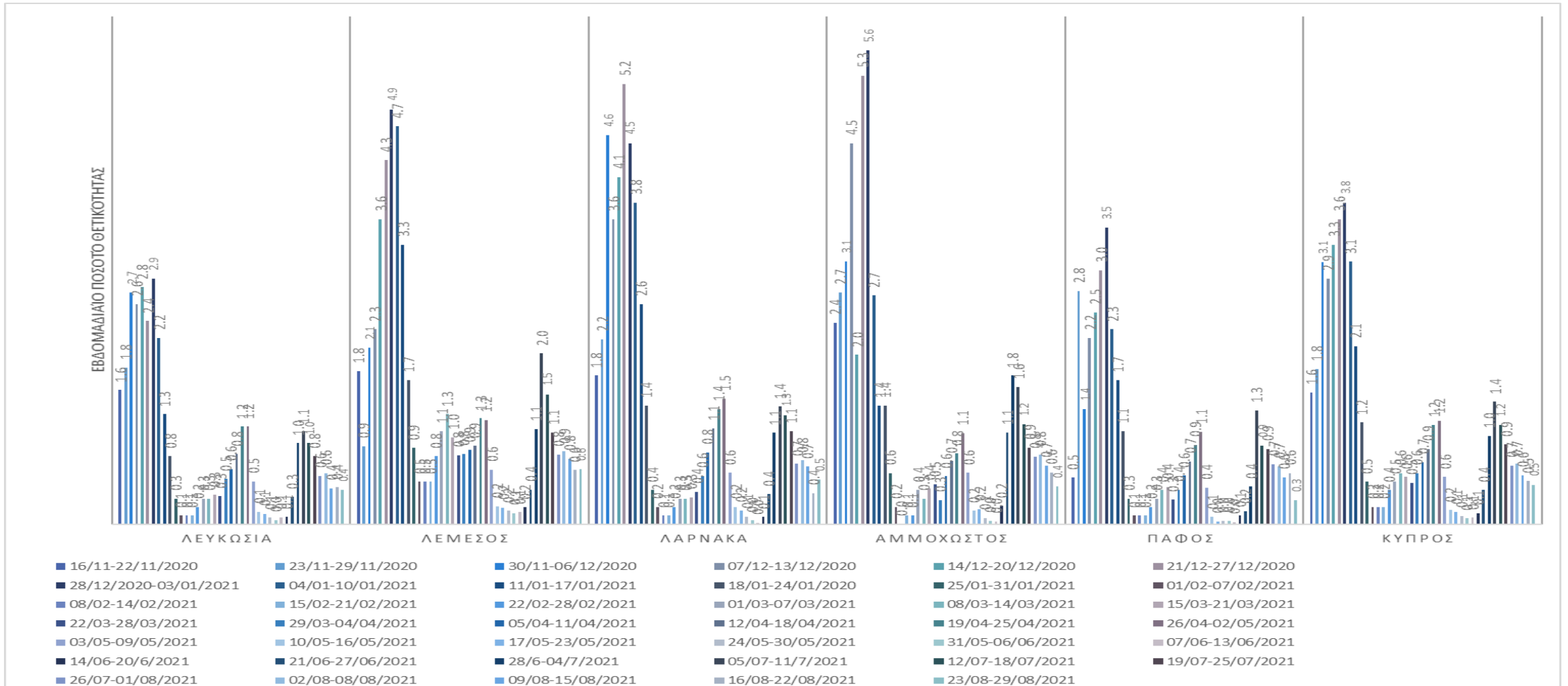
Percentage of laboratory tests (molecular) with a positive result (all labs), per week
