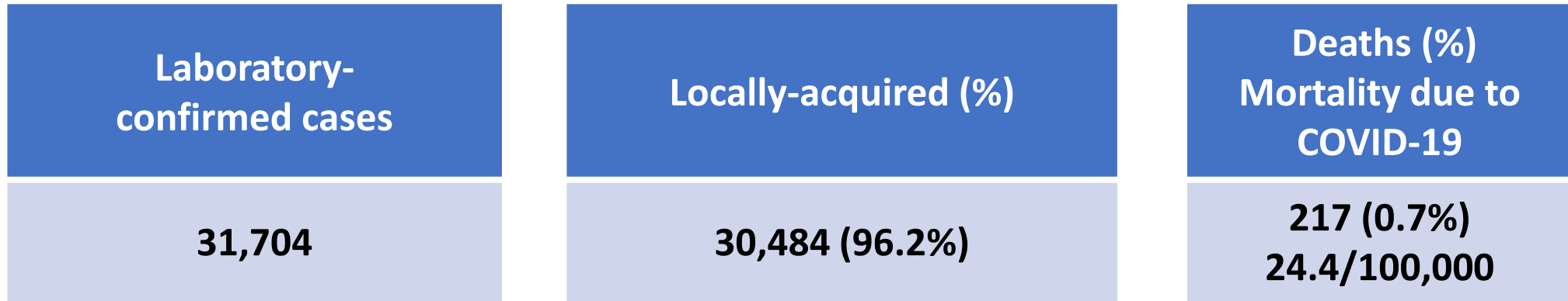

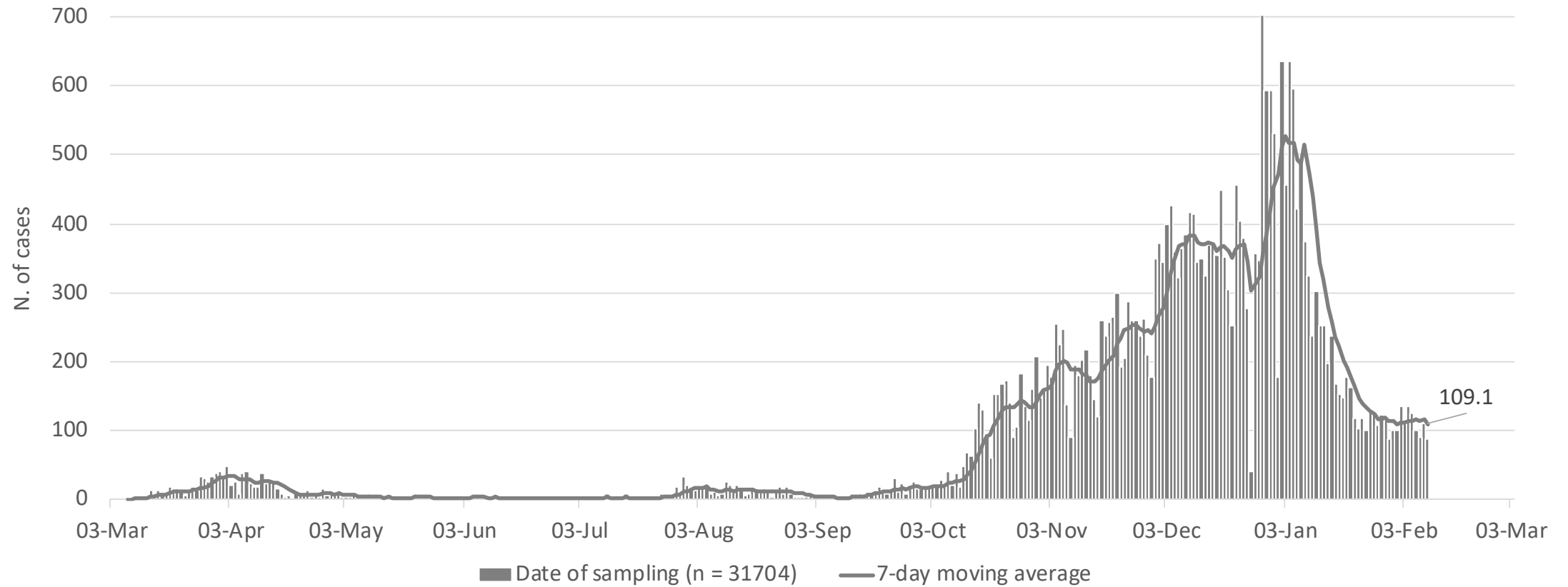

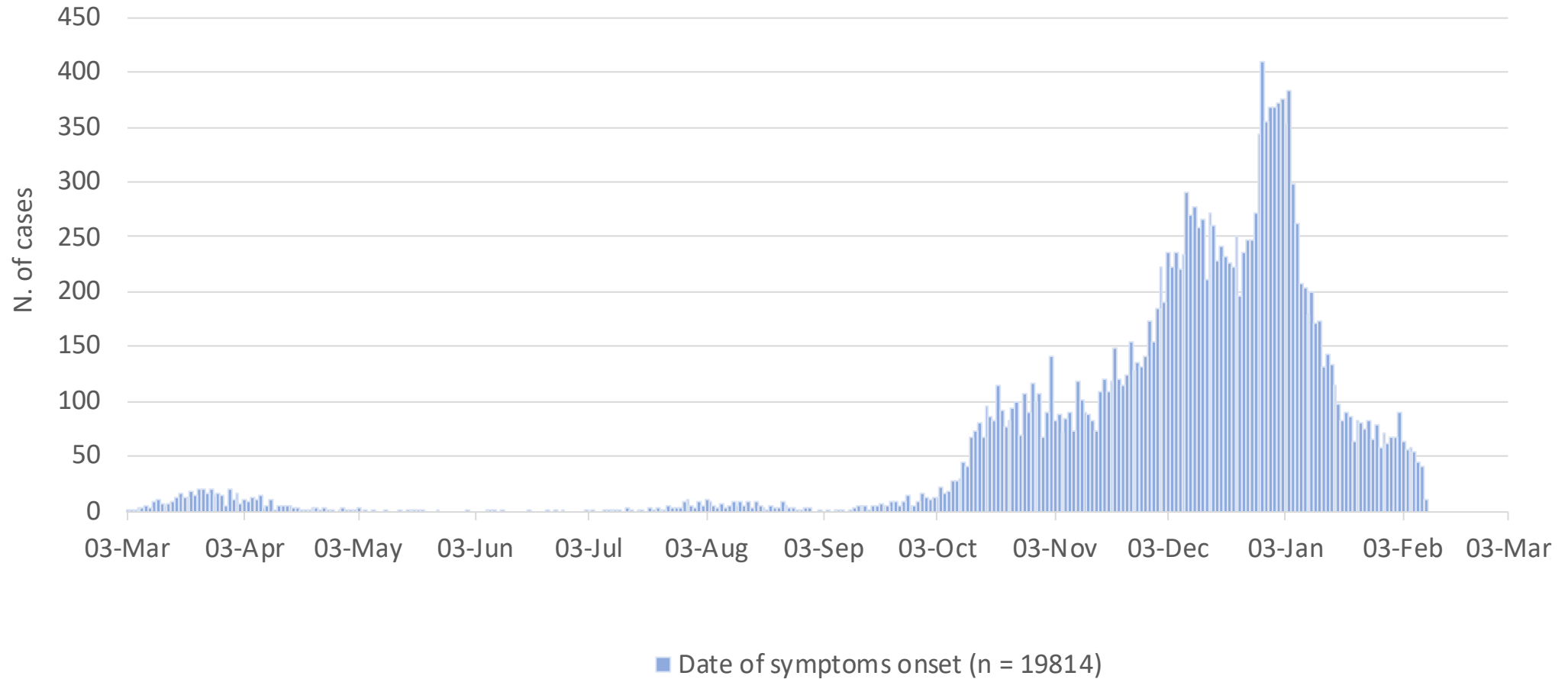

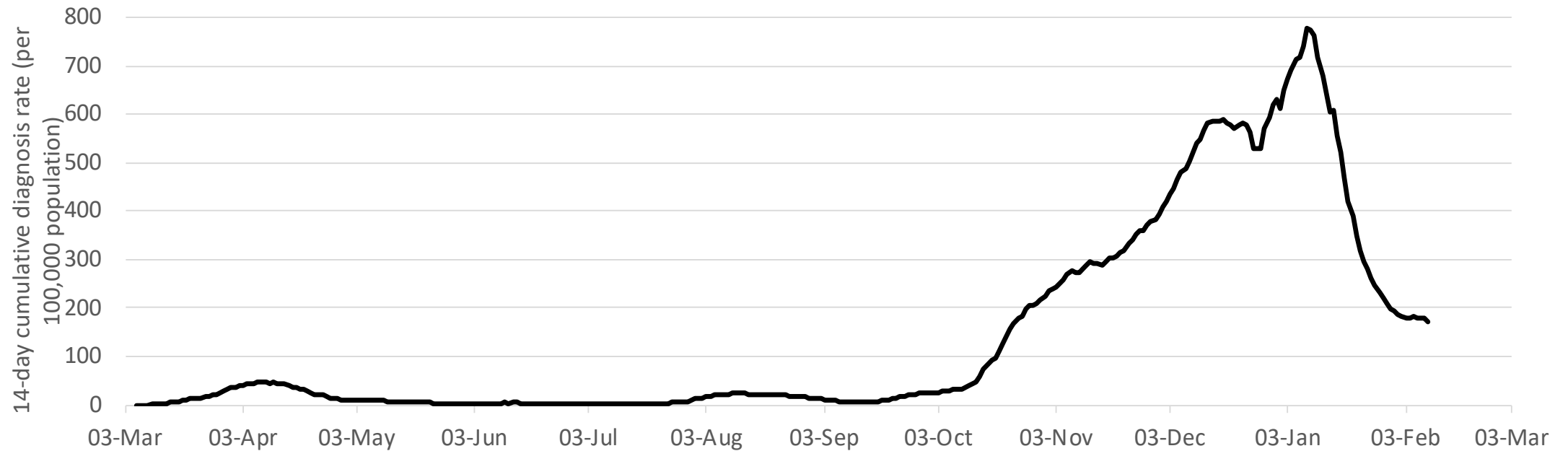


7-day moving average on Feb 9th is shown on the graph

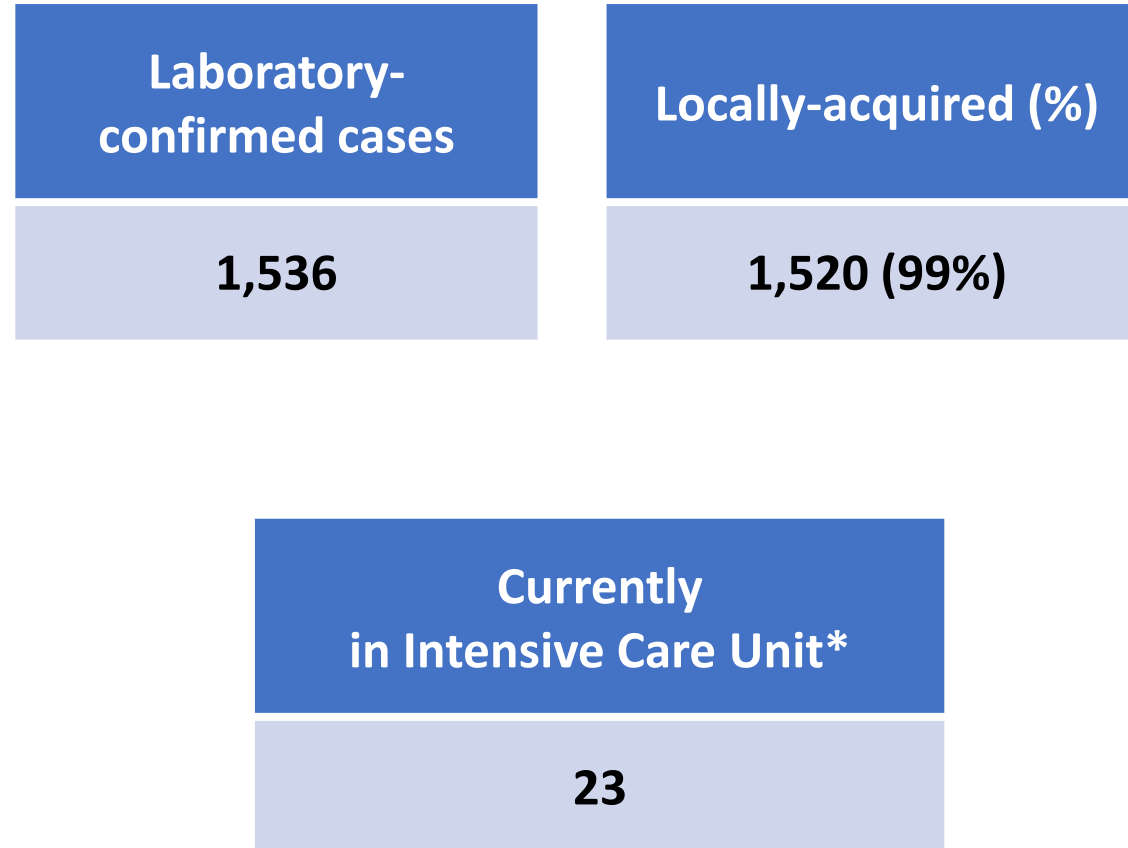
Laboratory-confirmed cases by date of symptom onset



COVID-19 14-day cumulative diagnosis rate per 100,000 population (proxy of COVID-19 prevalence)

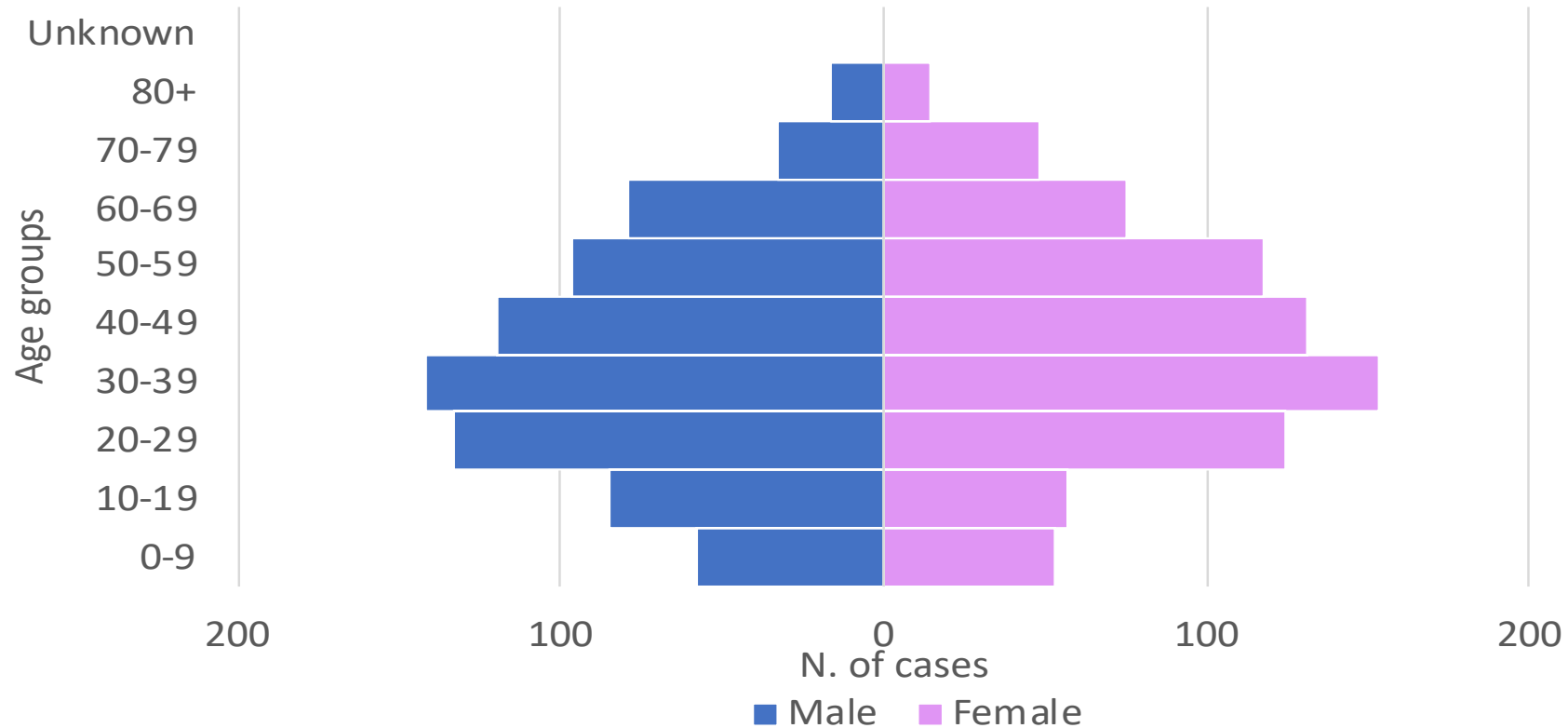

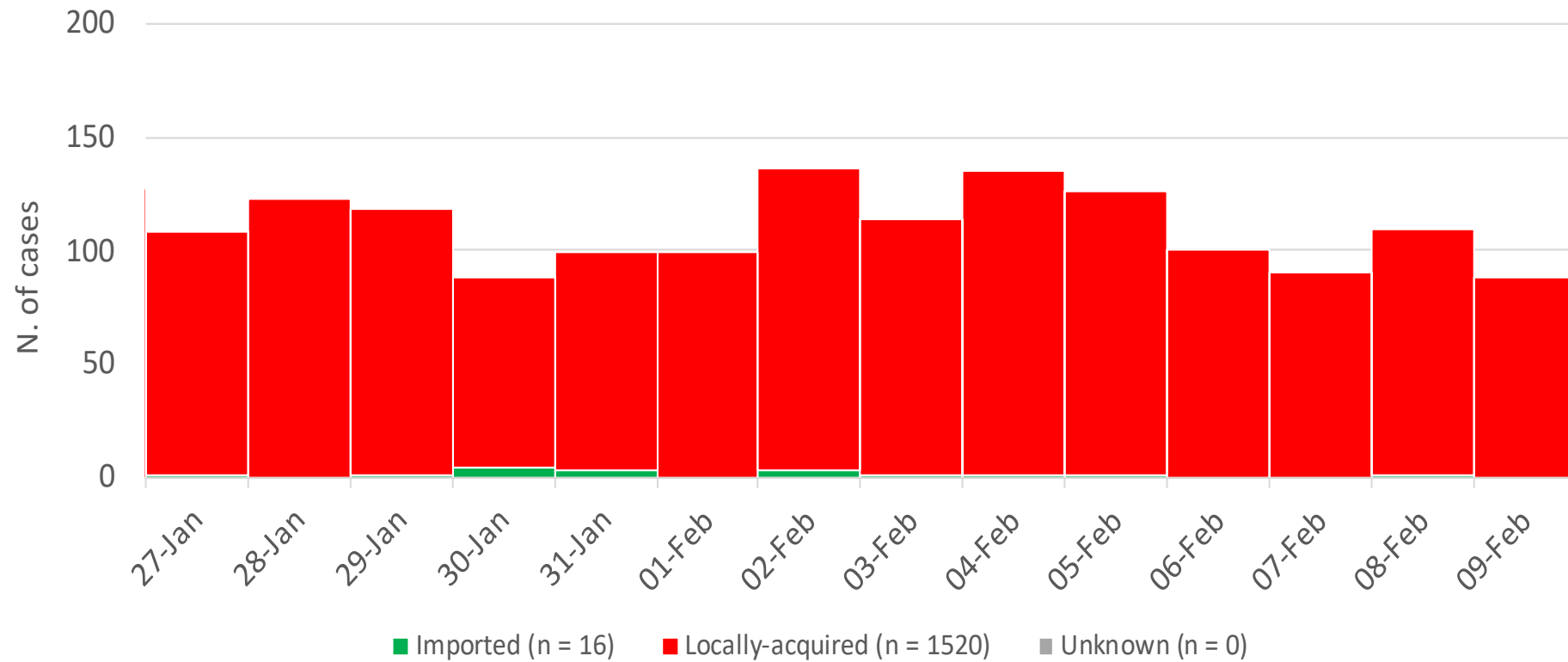

Distribution of cases diagnosed in the last 14 days by sex and age group (n = 1.536)

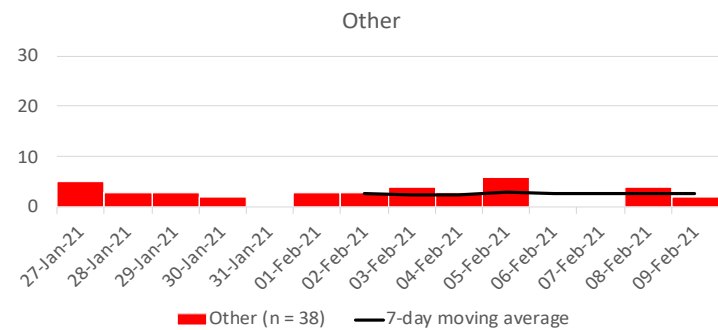
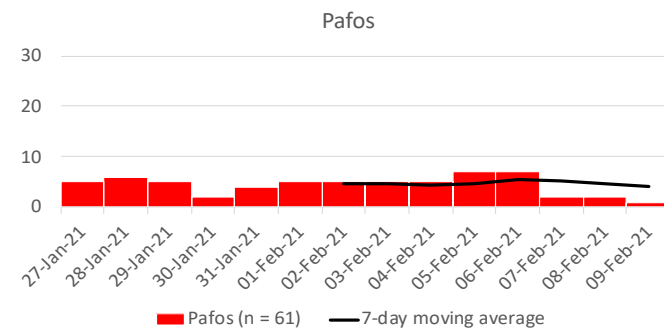
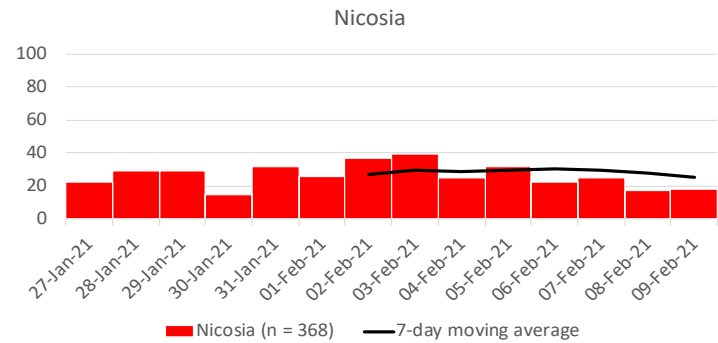
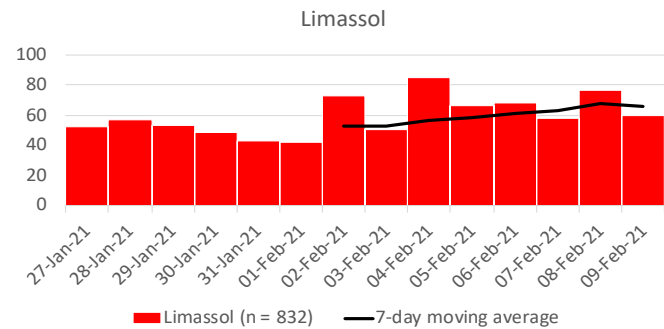
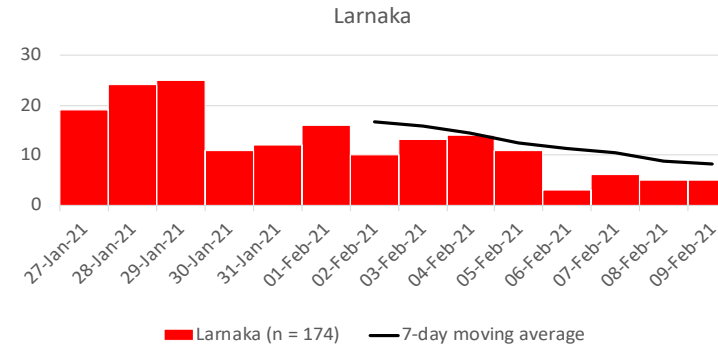
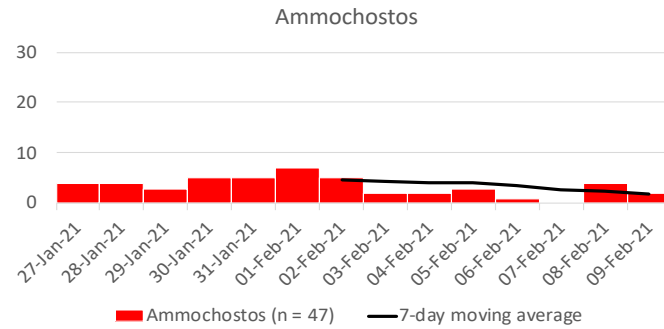

COVID-19 locally-acquired cases by date of sampling and district for the last 14 days

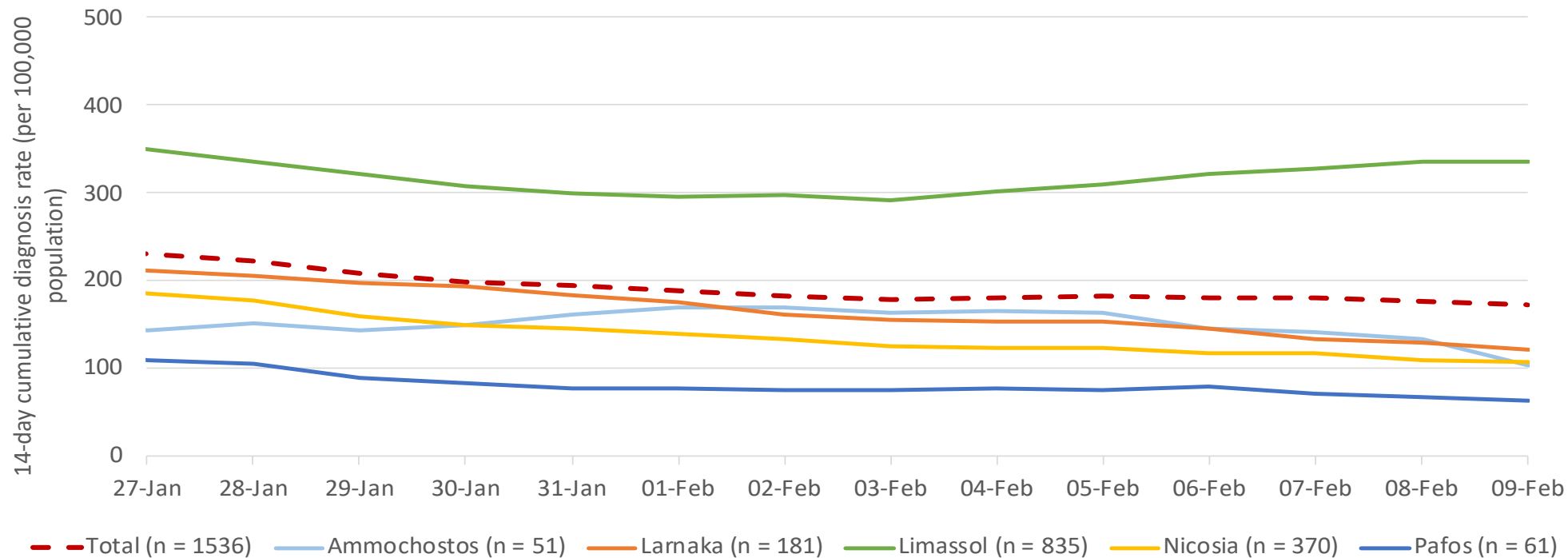

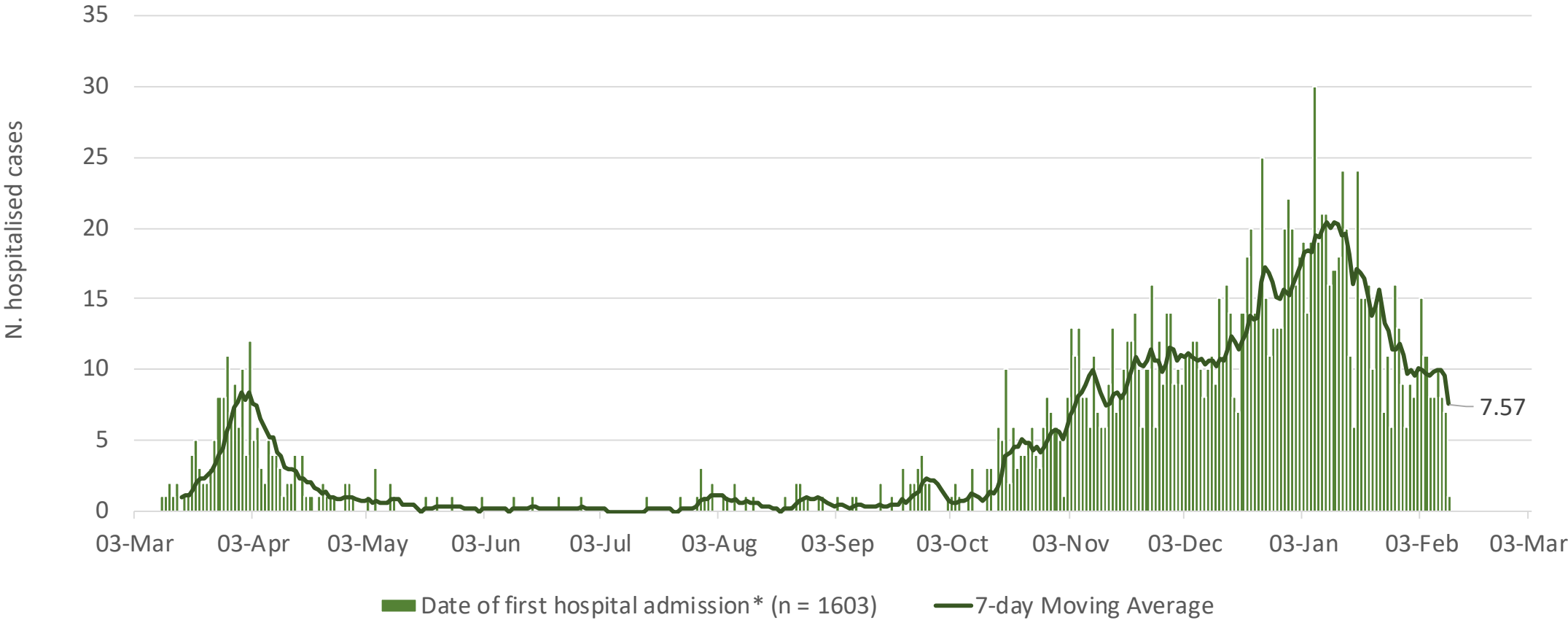

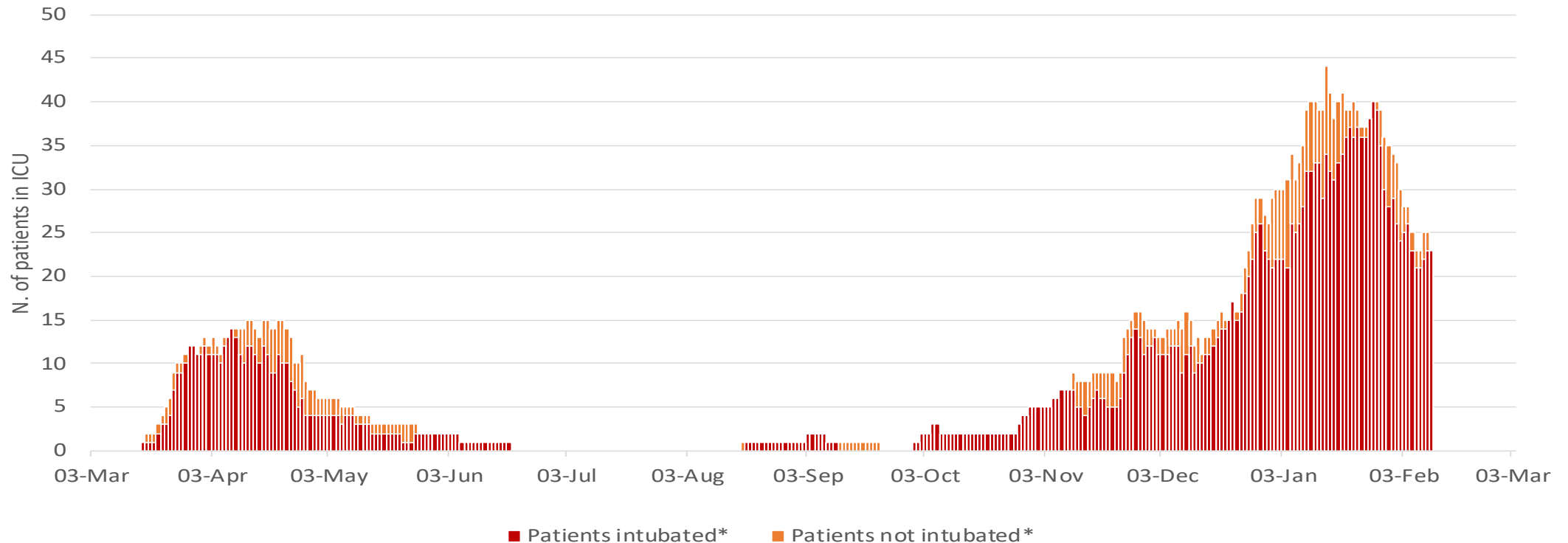
Number of cases by date of hospital admission

- Total: 166 (10,4% of all ever hospitalized patients) have ever been admitted to ICU – 23 currently in ICU (February 10th)

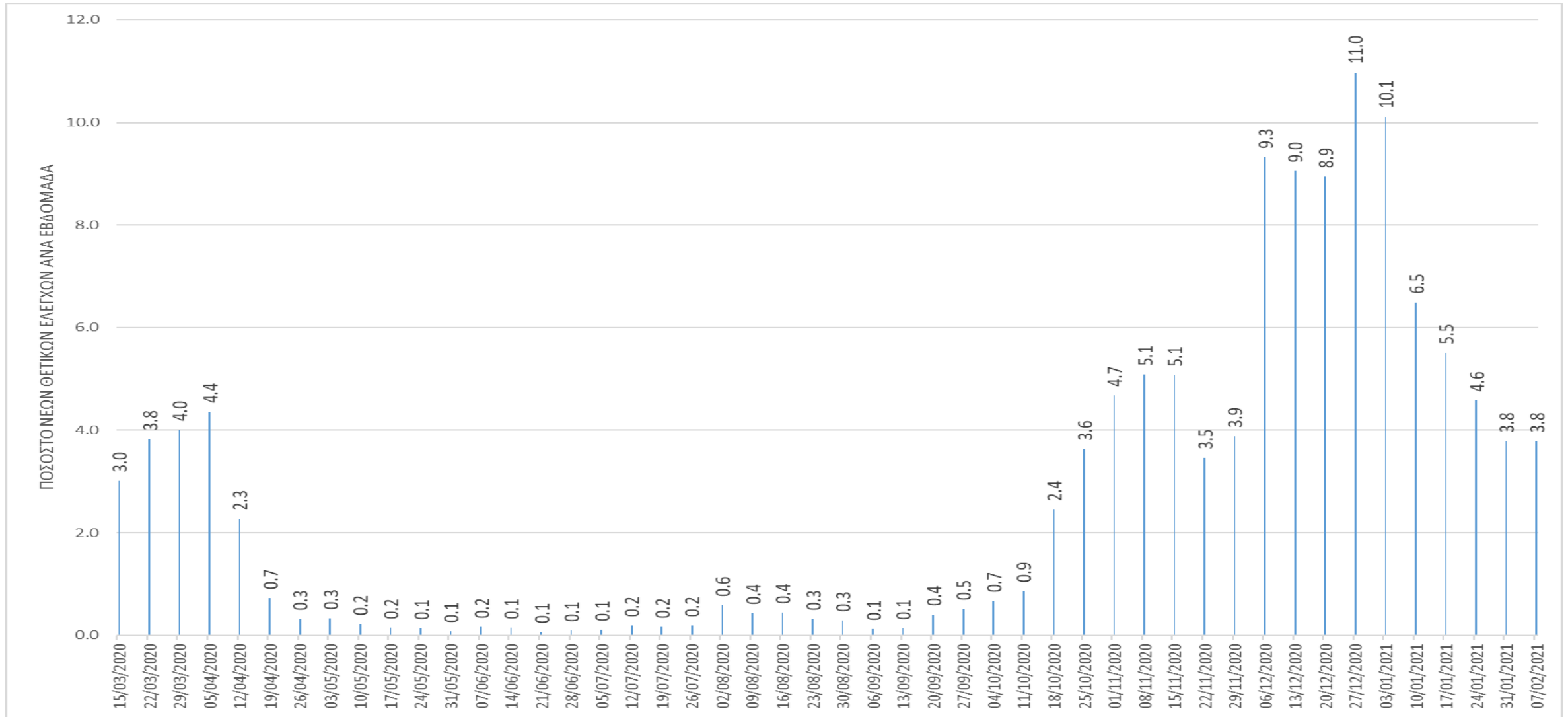

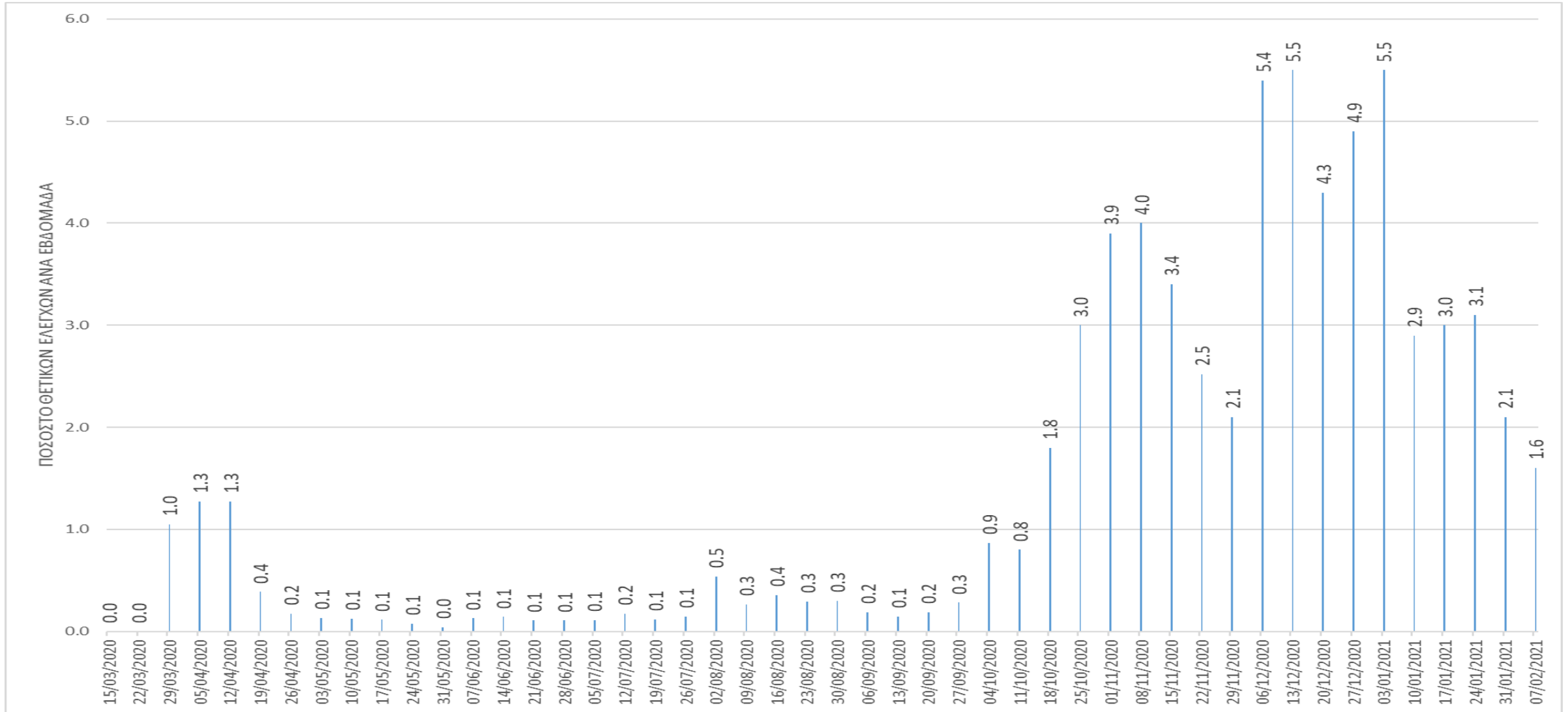

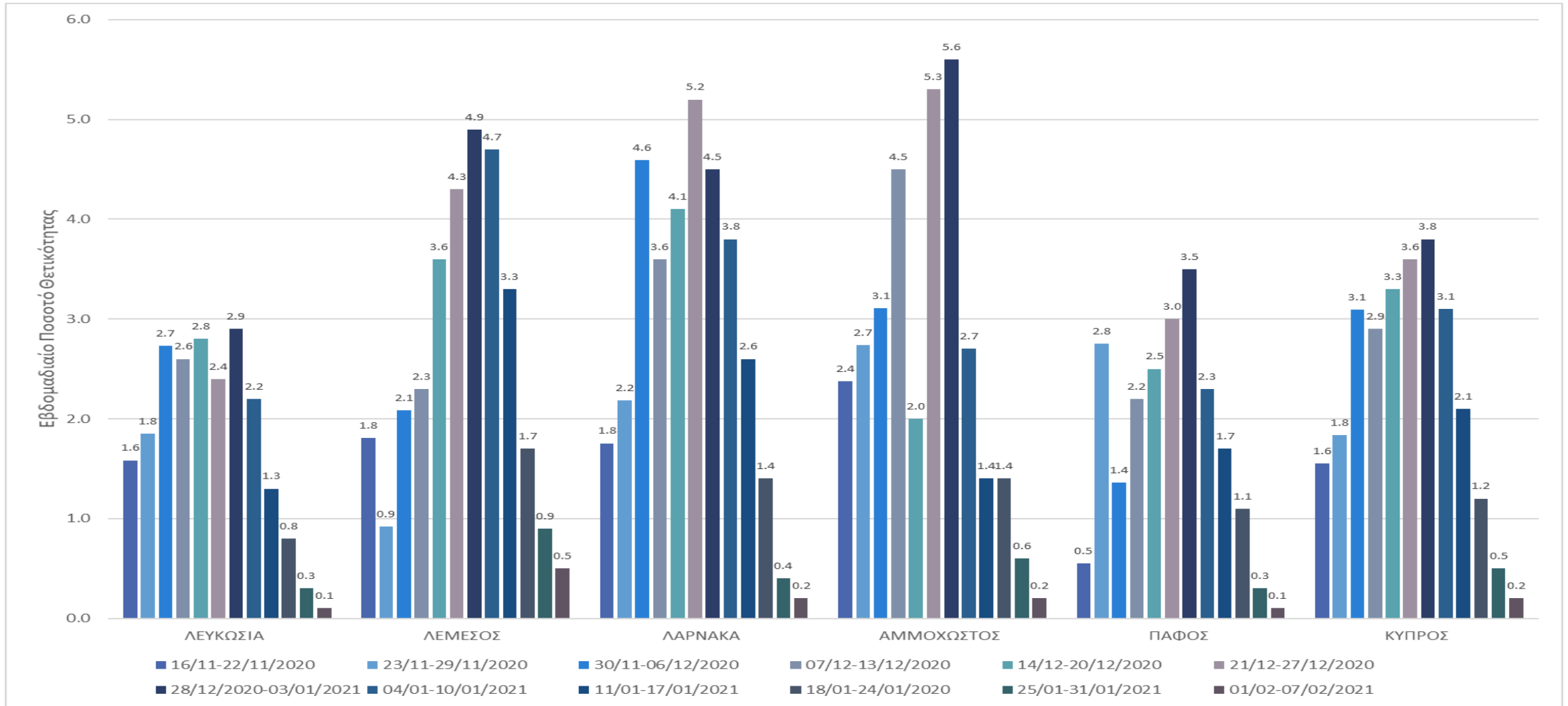
Percentage of new laboratory tests (molecular) with a positive result (all labs), per week
